The attractive brunette queen reigned at the Post-Game Dance in Powell School.

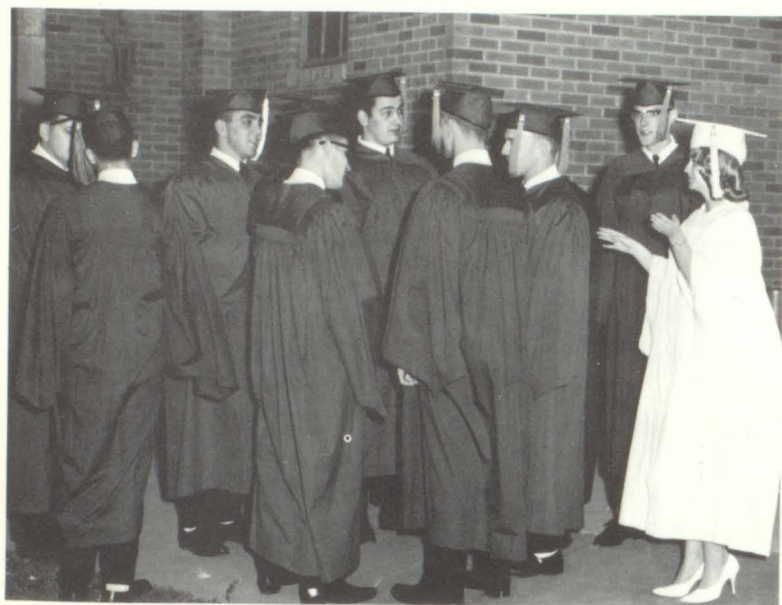
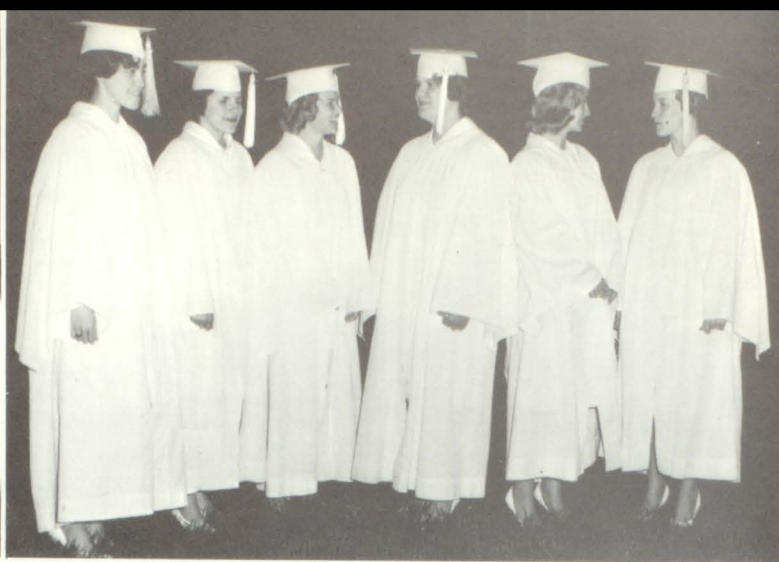

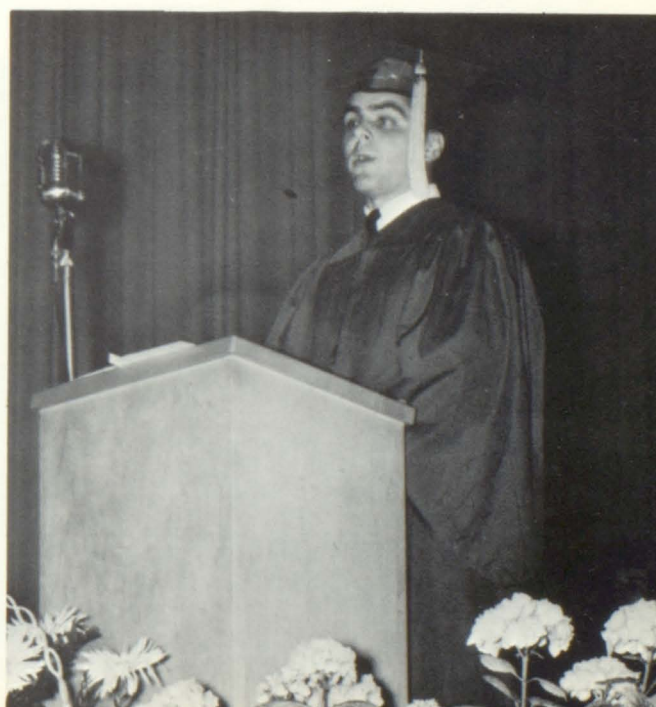

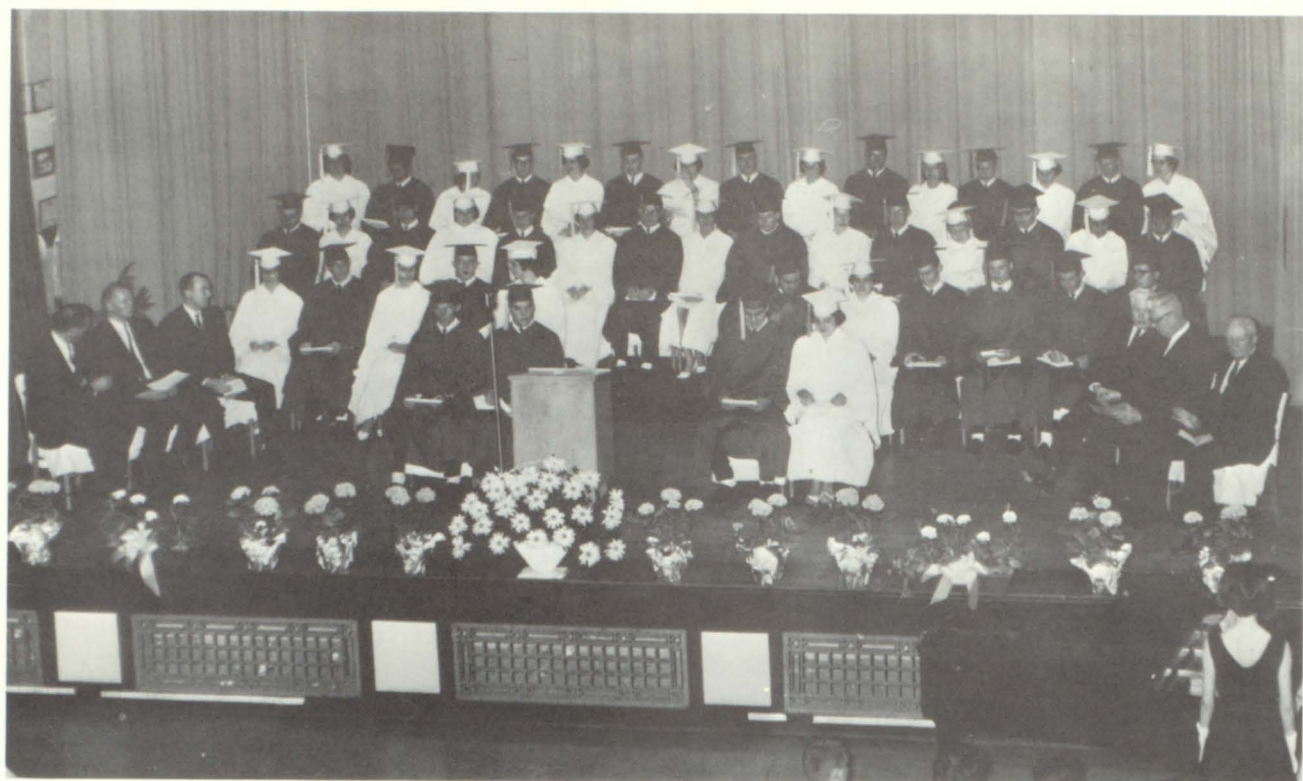
