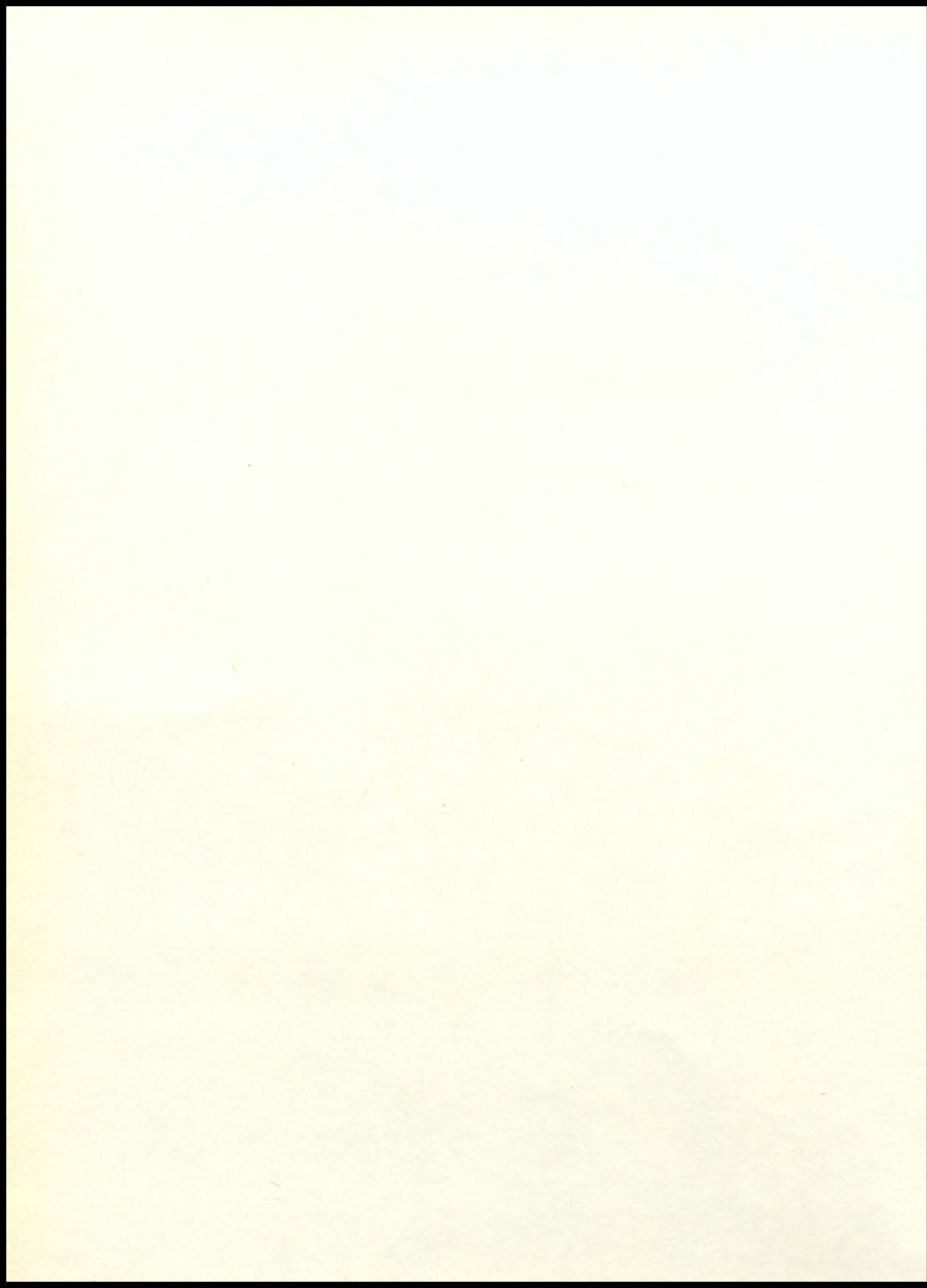

He did his undergraduate work at Findlay College and received his Master of Education degree from Toledo University.

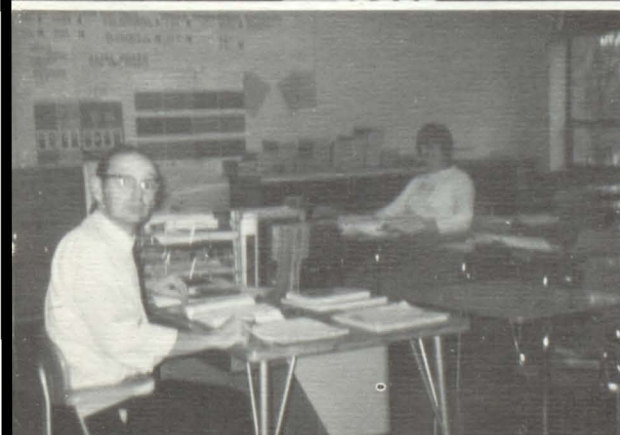
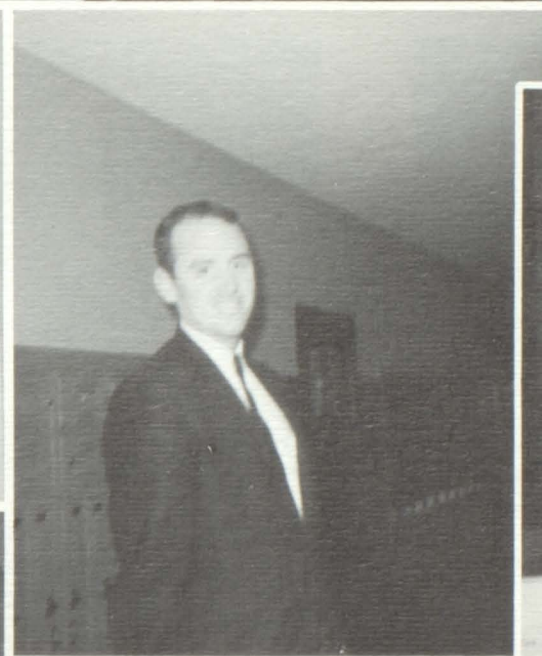
