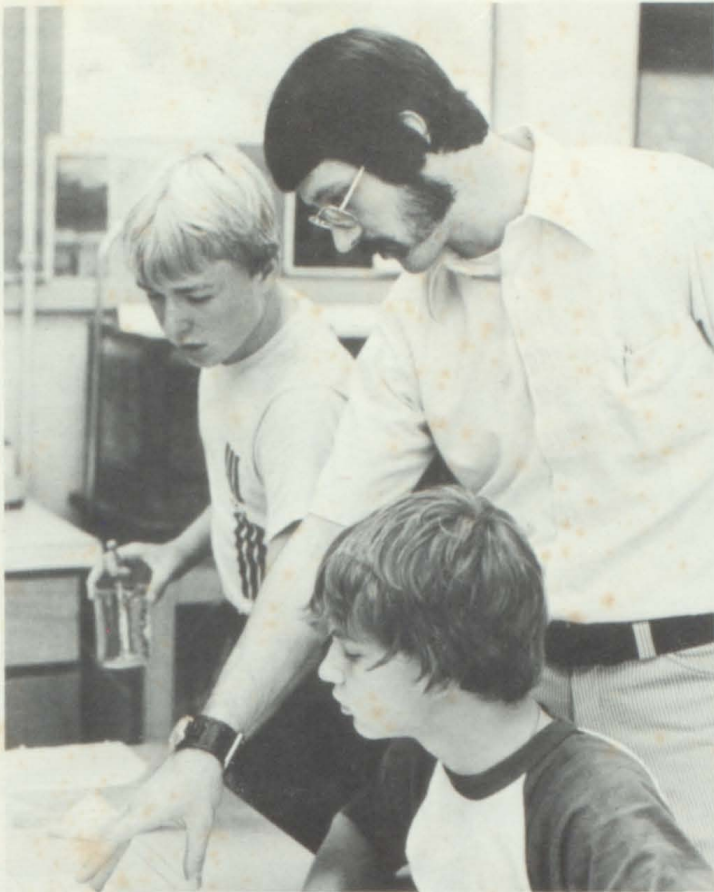
THOMAS F. Oldcorn



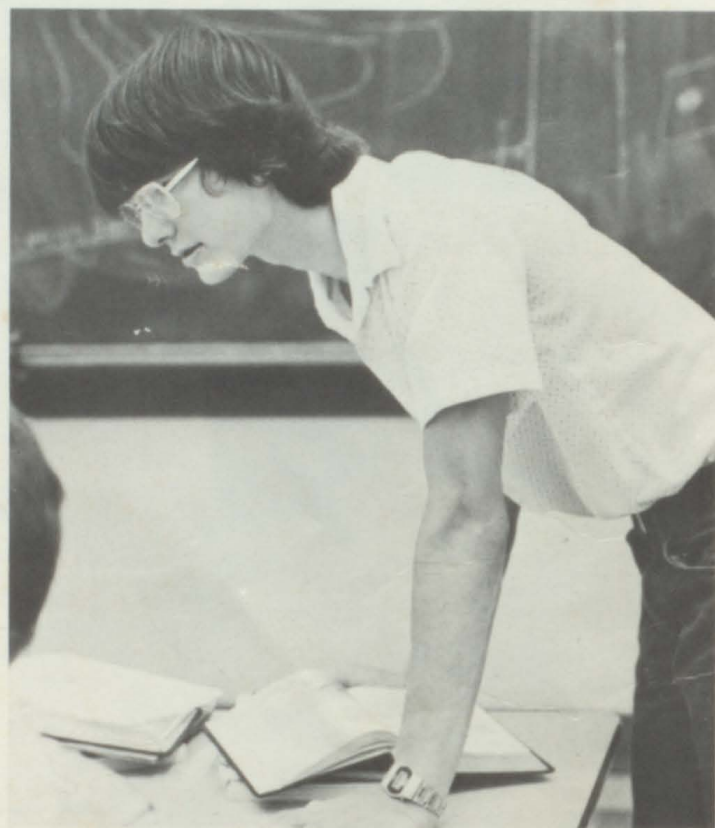
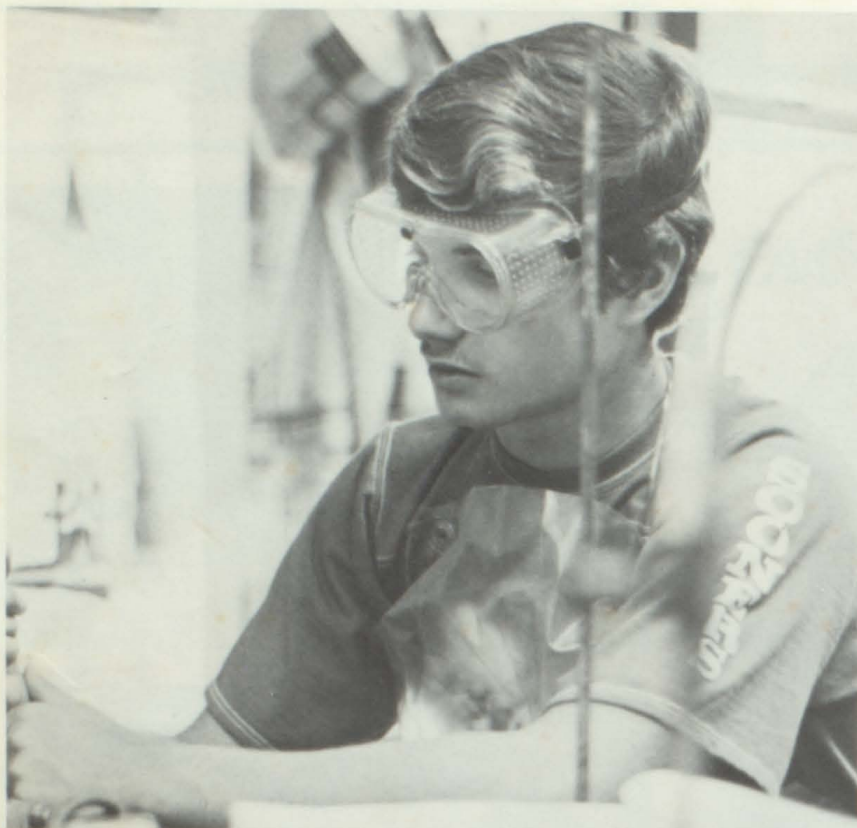

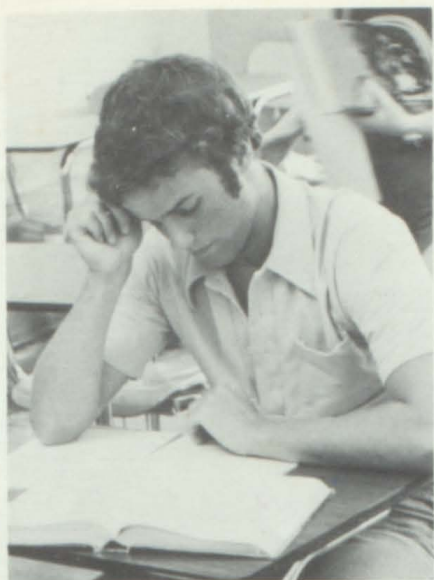

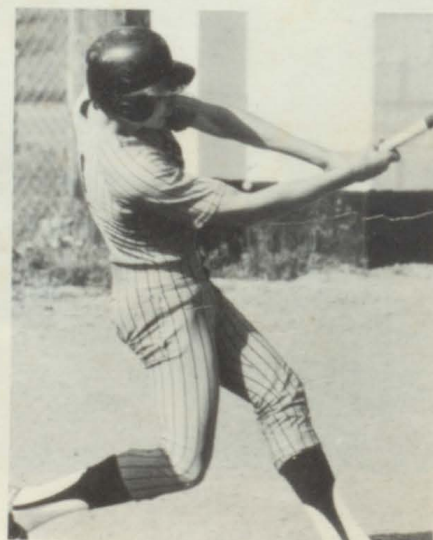

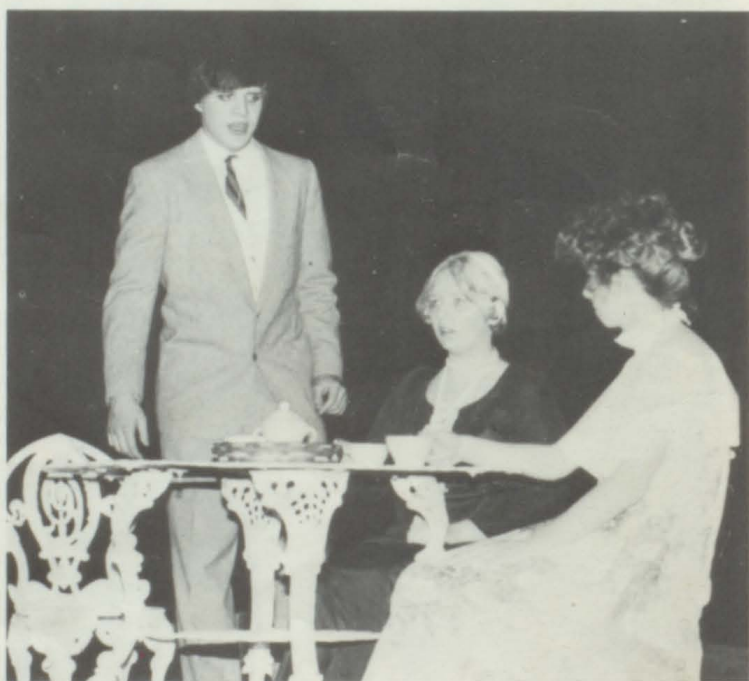

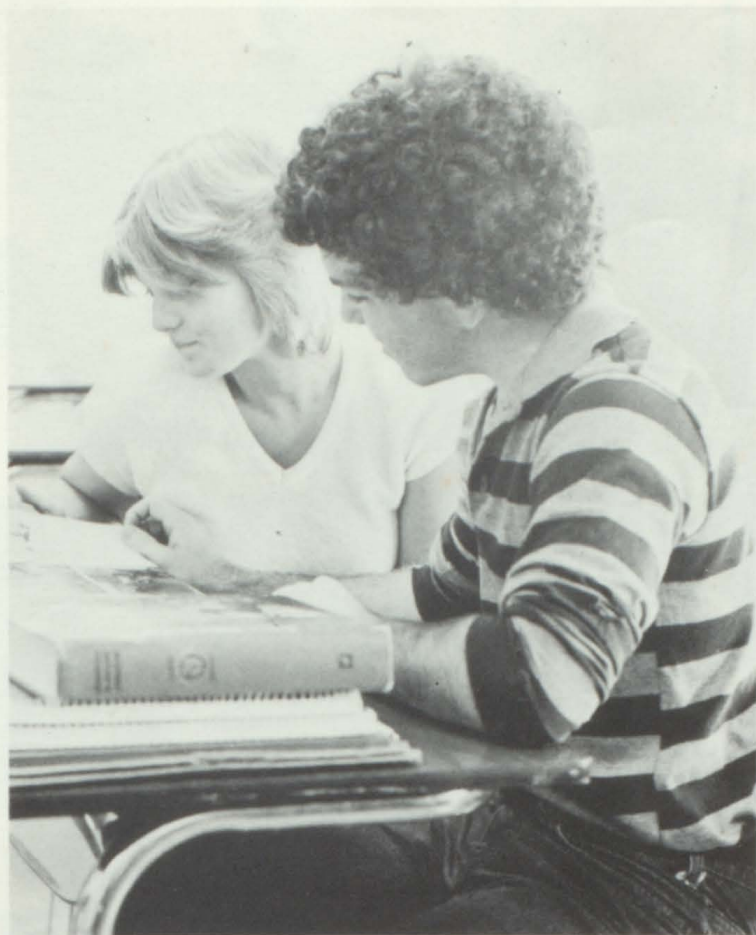

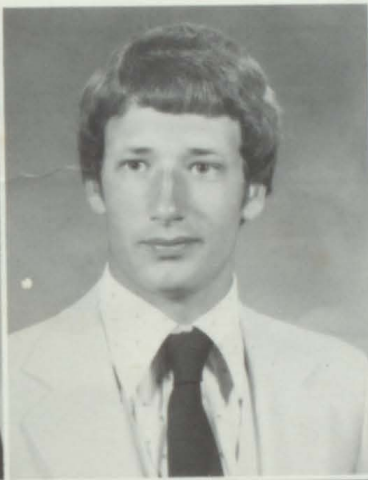

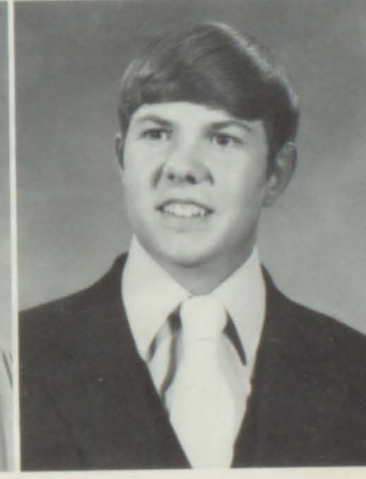

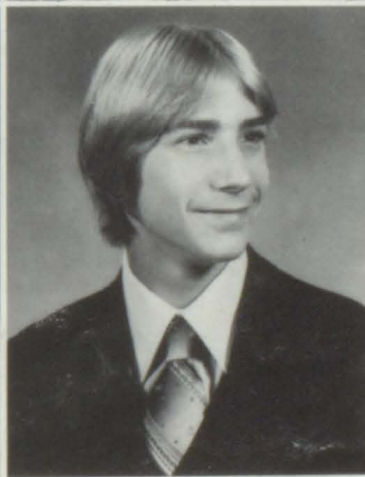
