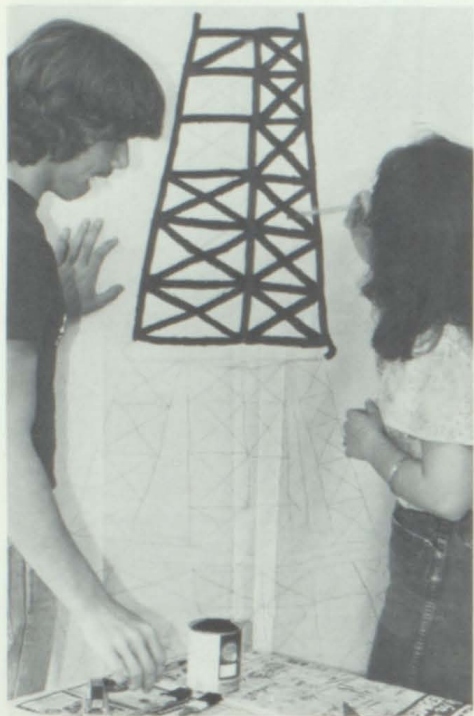

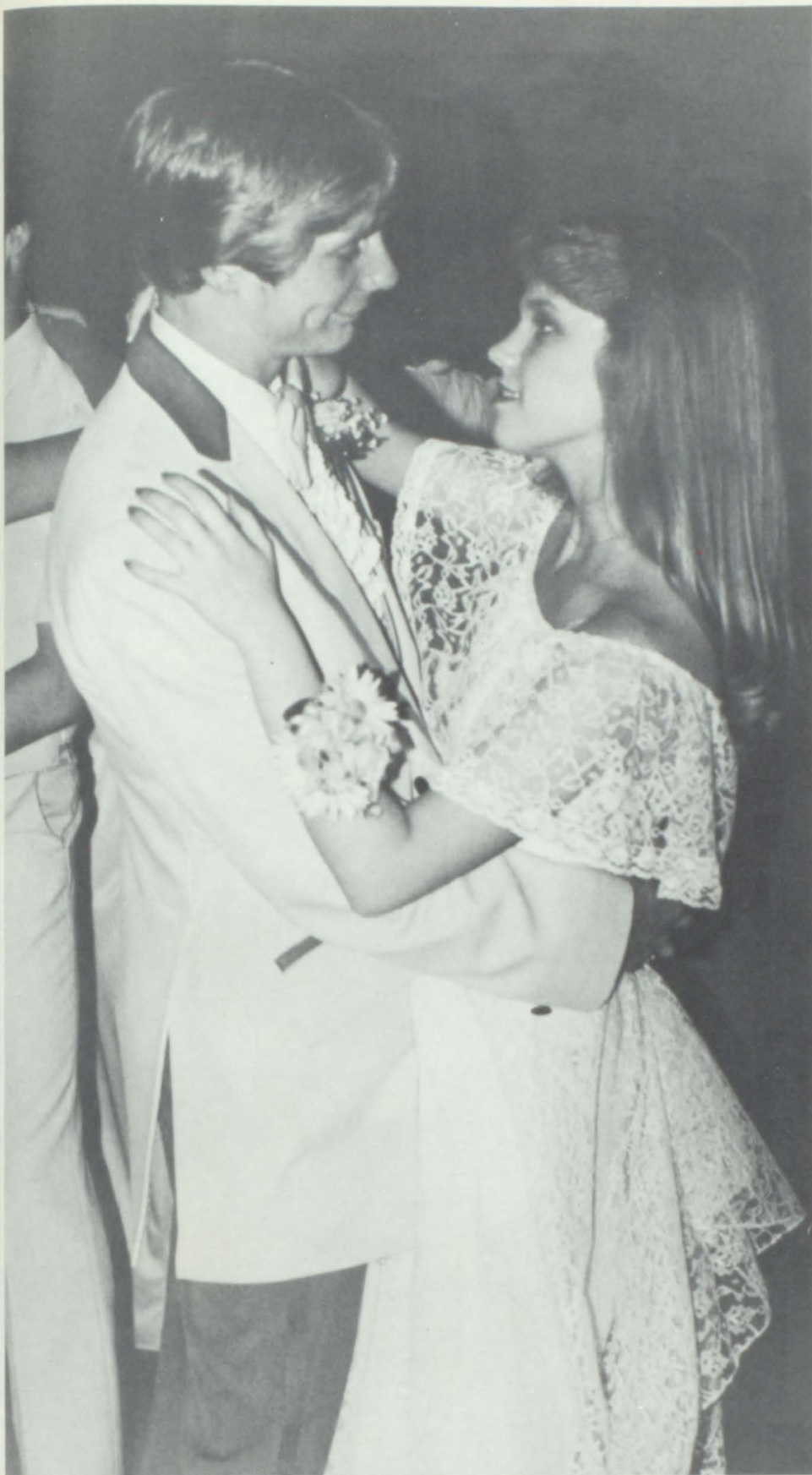

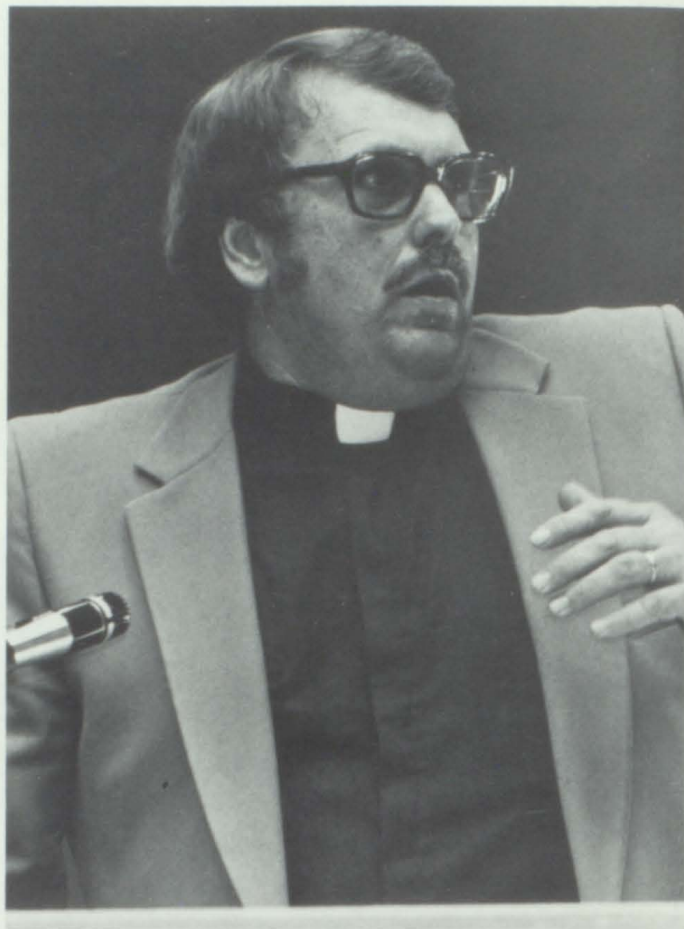

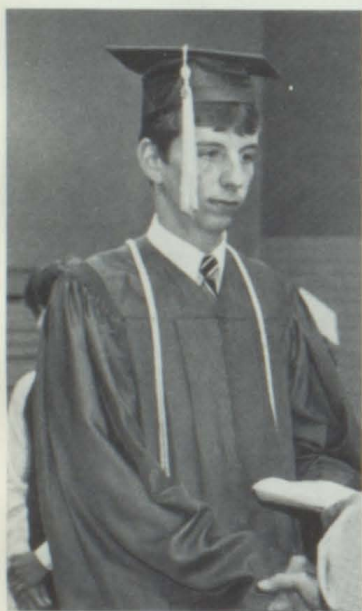

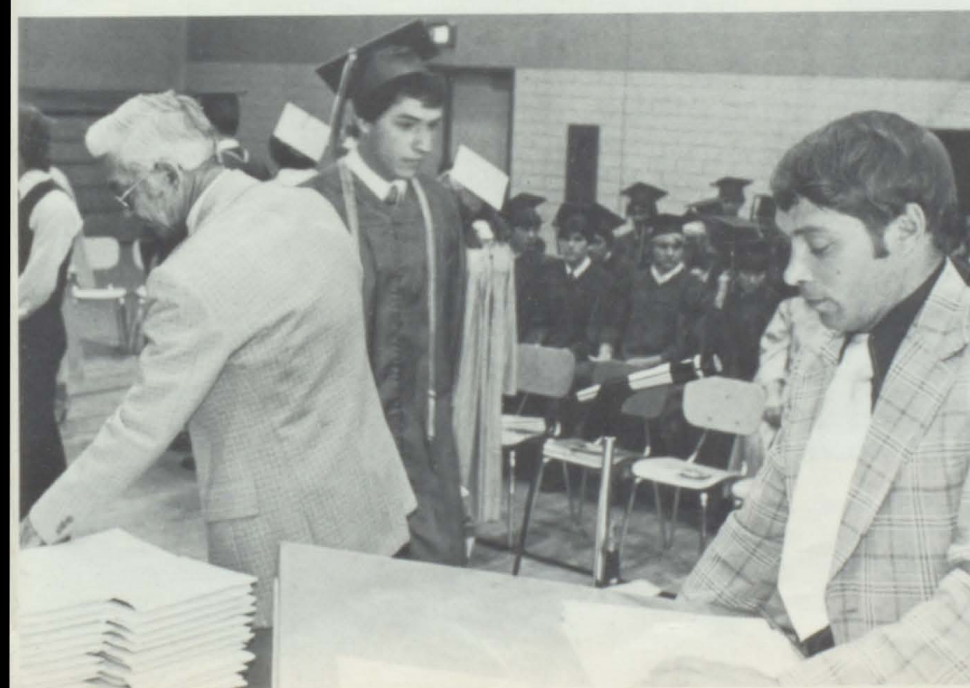

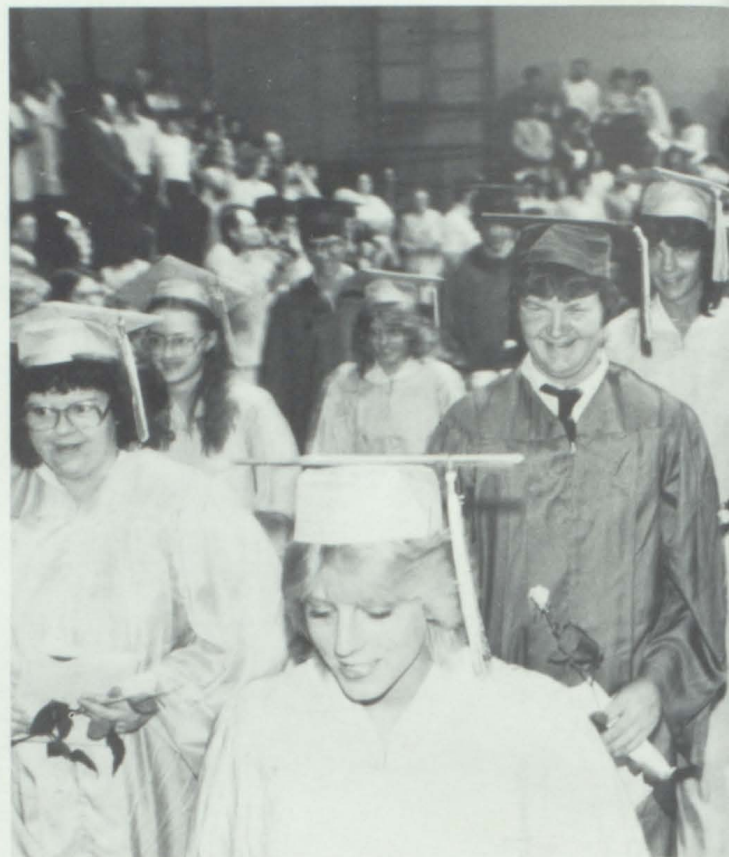

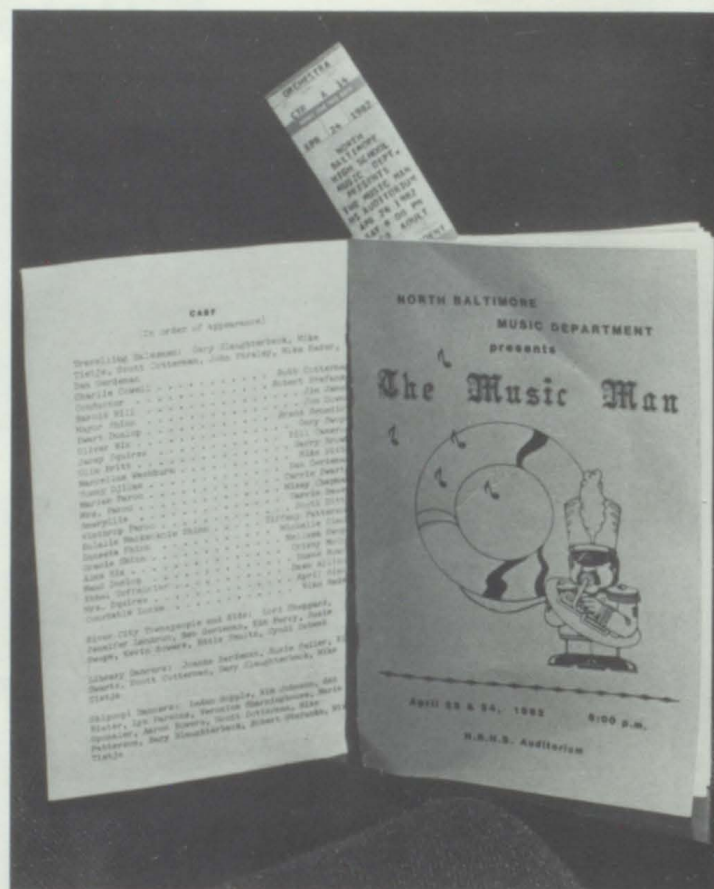


NBHS Music Department Presents "The Music Man" April 23 and 24
