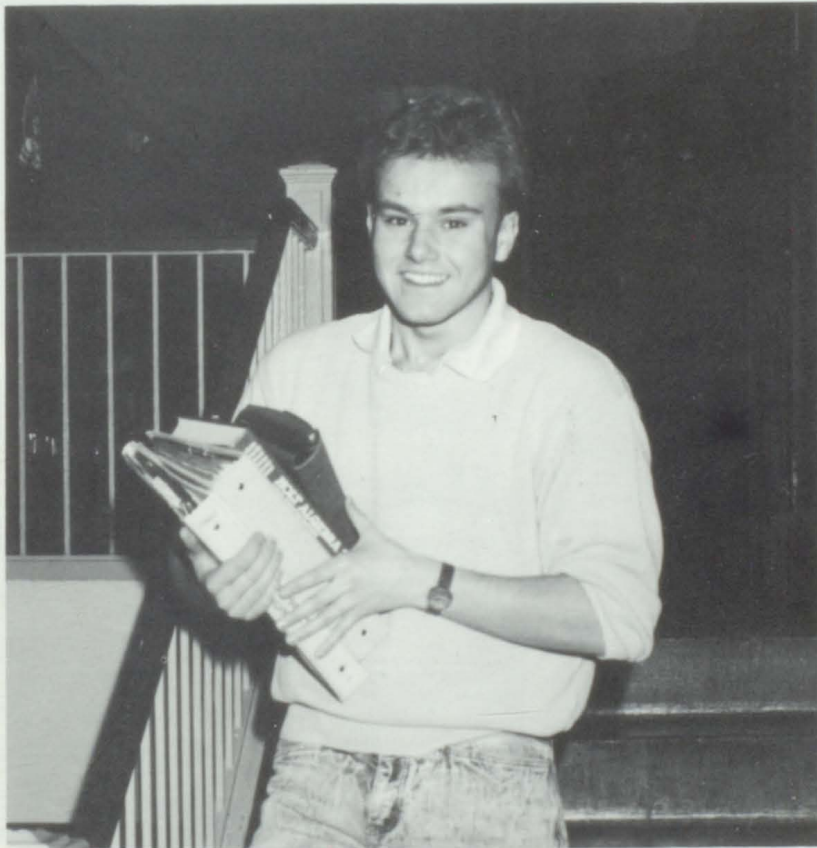


A Note From Peter

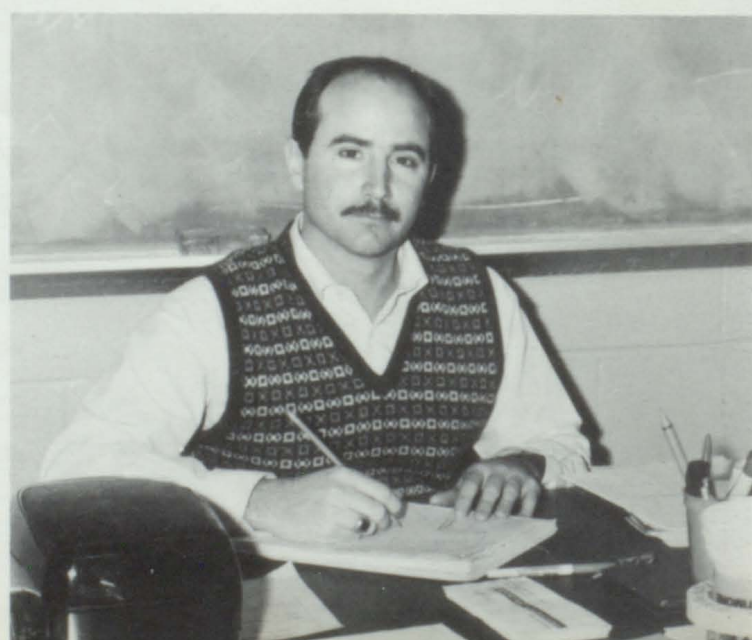


Upper Left: Carlos and Peter learn about each other's country as well as America.

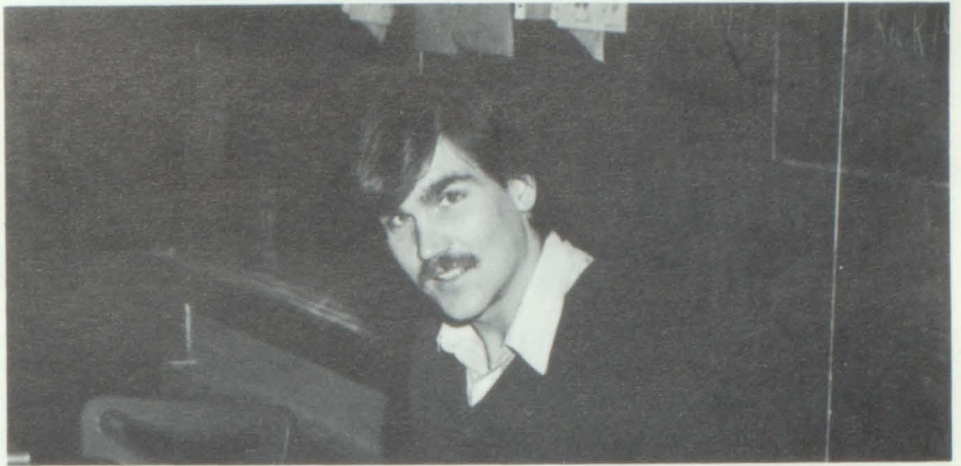

Social studies teacher DON

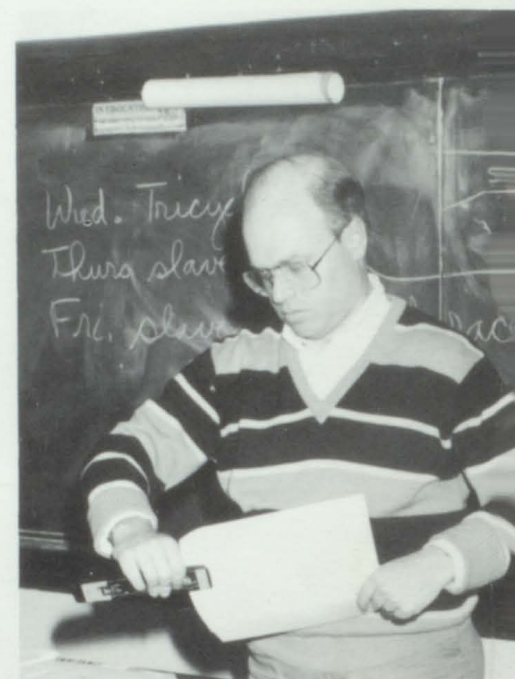

But we also know when to shut up because she starts rolling her eyes, and points her pen at you.

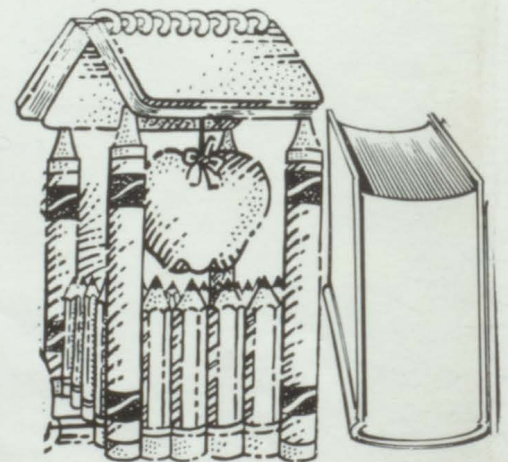
After reading this article, we suggest students be on their best behavior when one of these teachers shows any of the symptoms listed above.

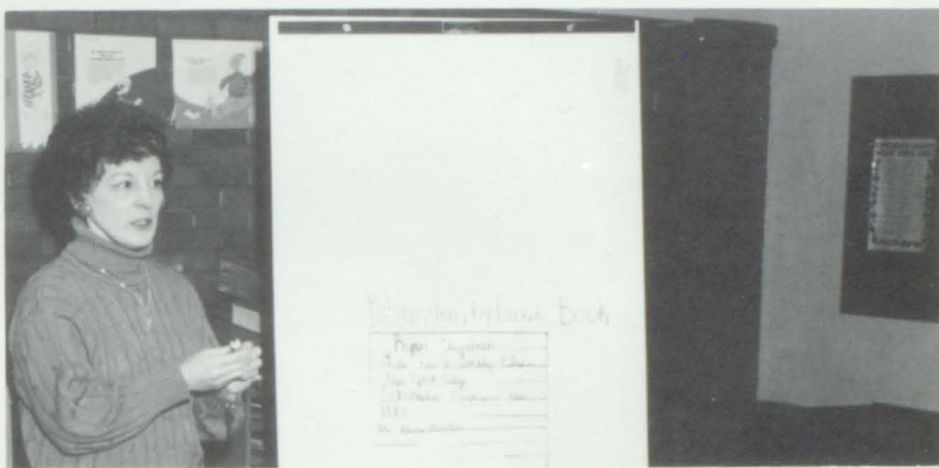
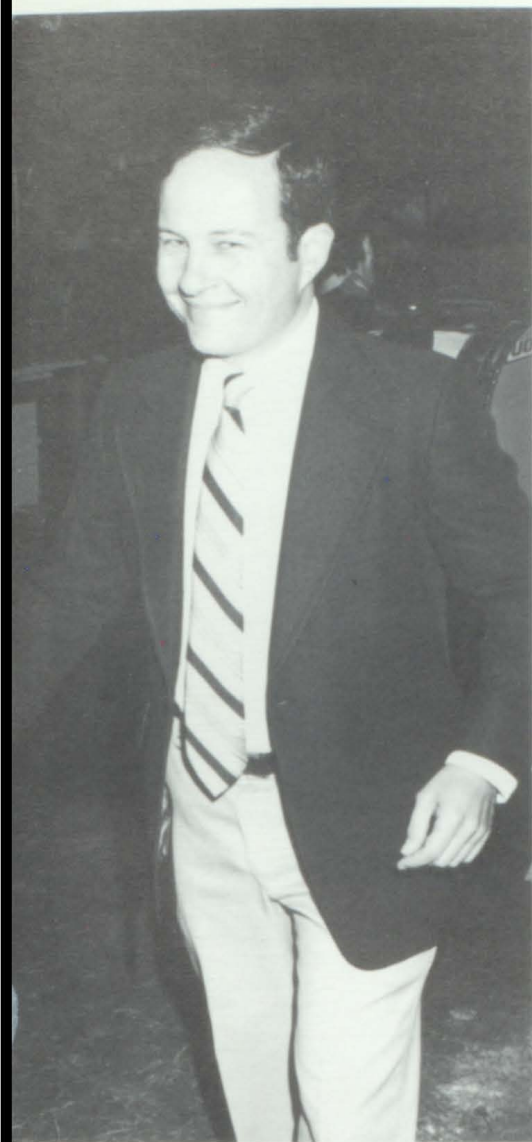
