Mrs. Weith wore a cast for three weeks and was in a leg brace for four weeks.

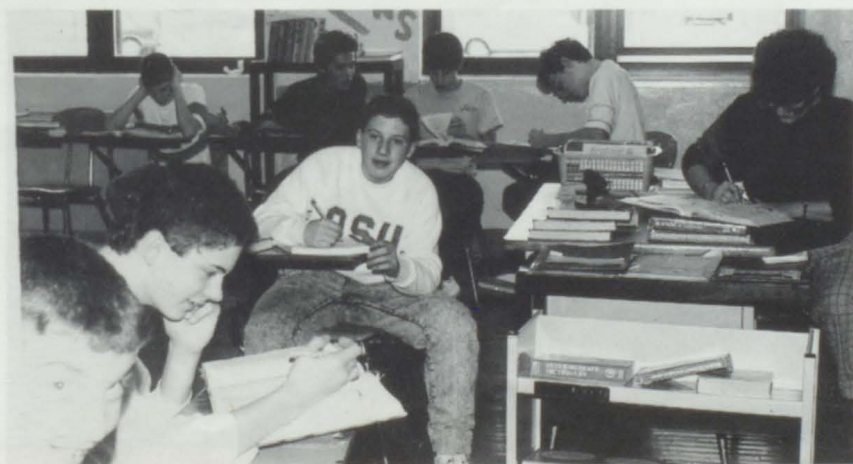
Mrs. Weith was finally able to put a little bit of weight on her left foot in late March. She fell twice after the original fall.
