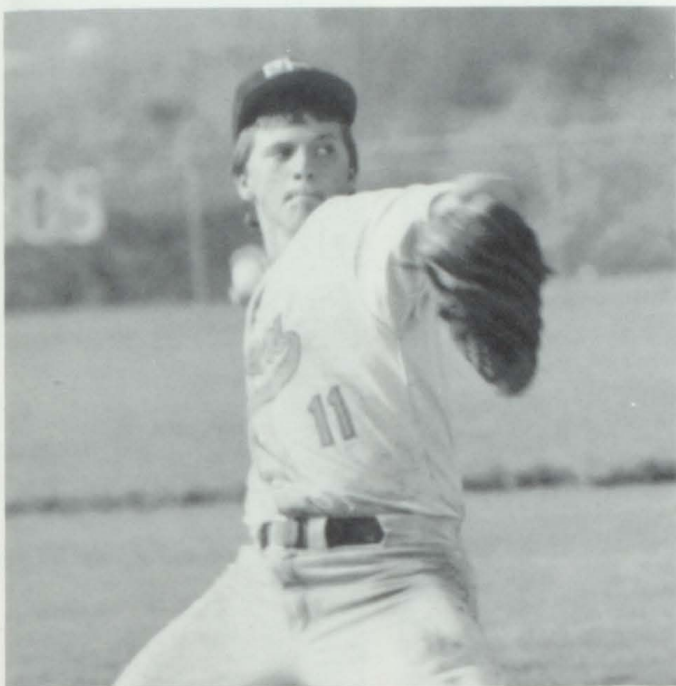

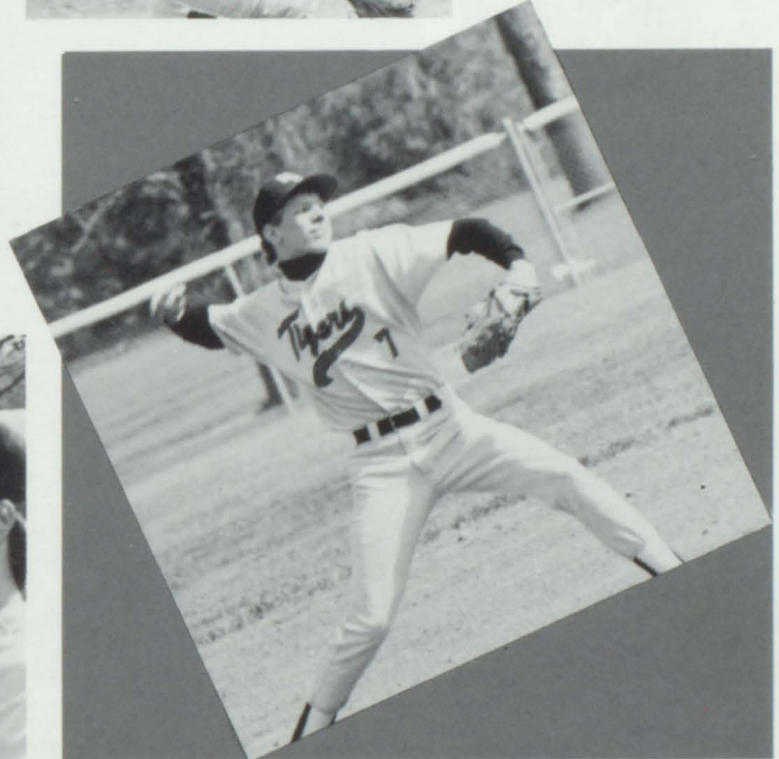




Ryan Brumbaugh watches the pitcher while he is on deck. Jeff Long throws the ball to second. Joe Kepling runs hard to win the game.

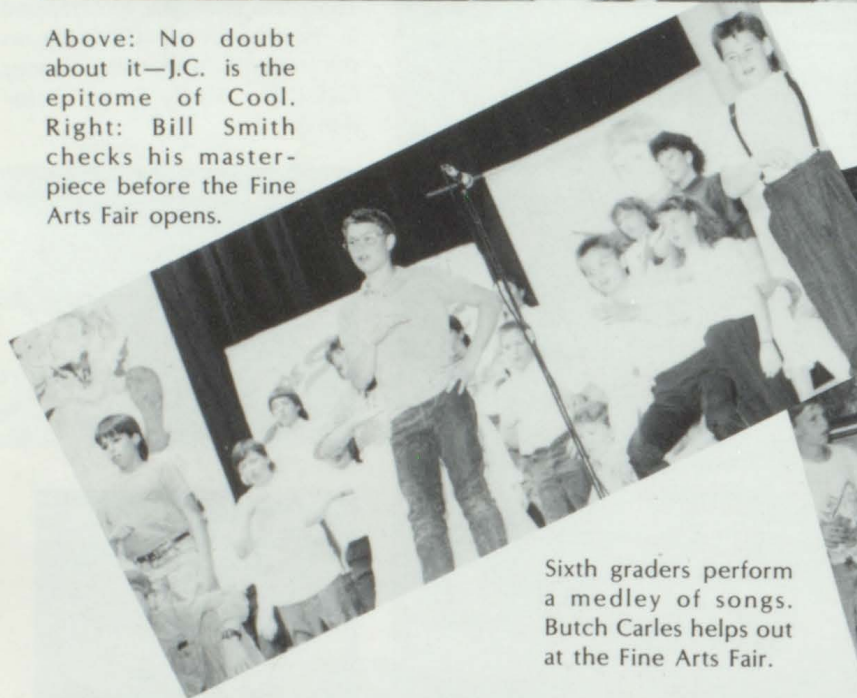

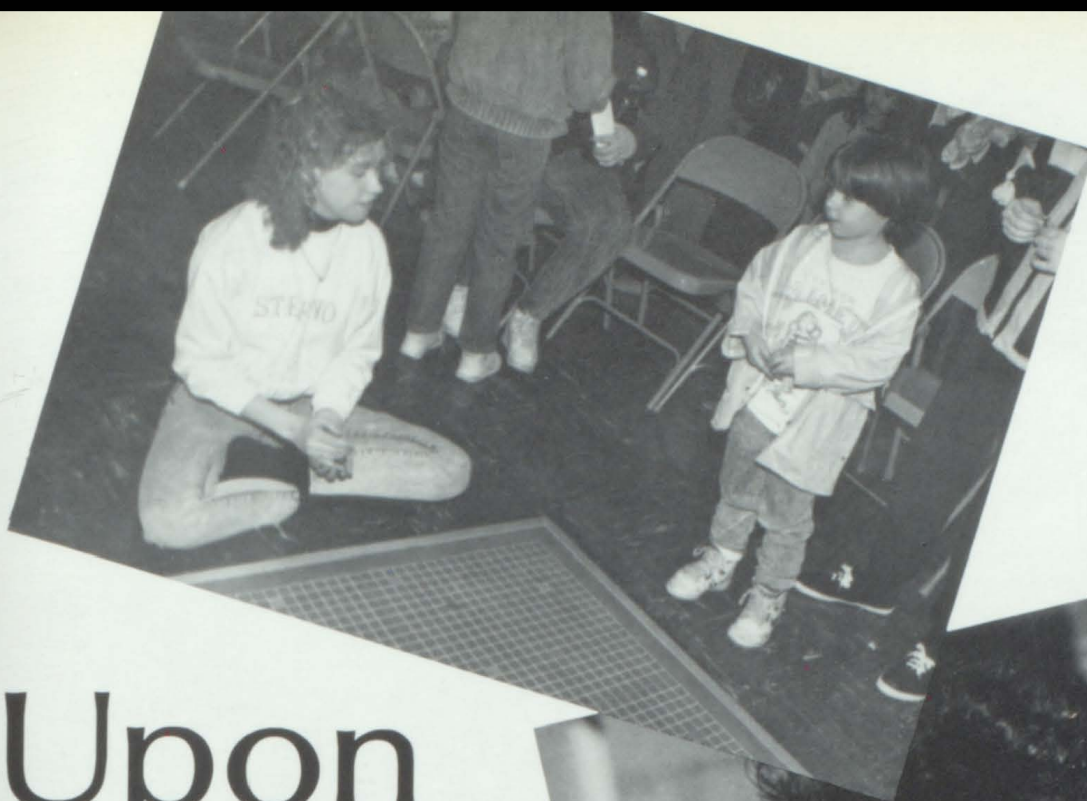

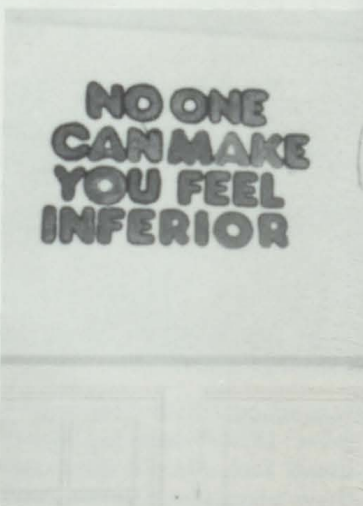

Many people helped with the play including the stage crew, Eric Swope and Tim Phillips, the director of the play, Fran Weith and, of course, the cast.



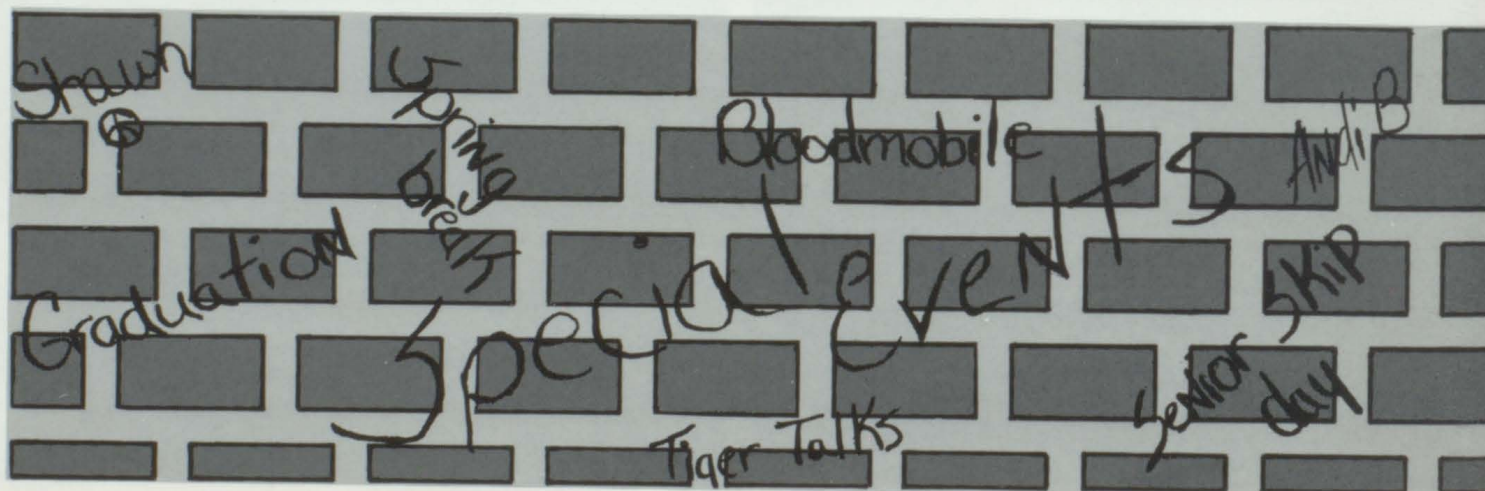
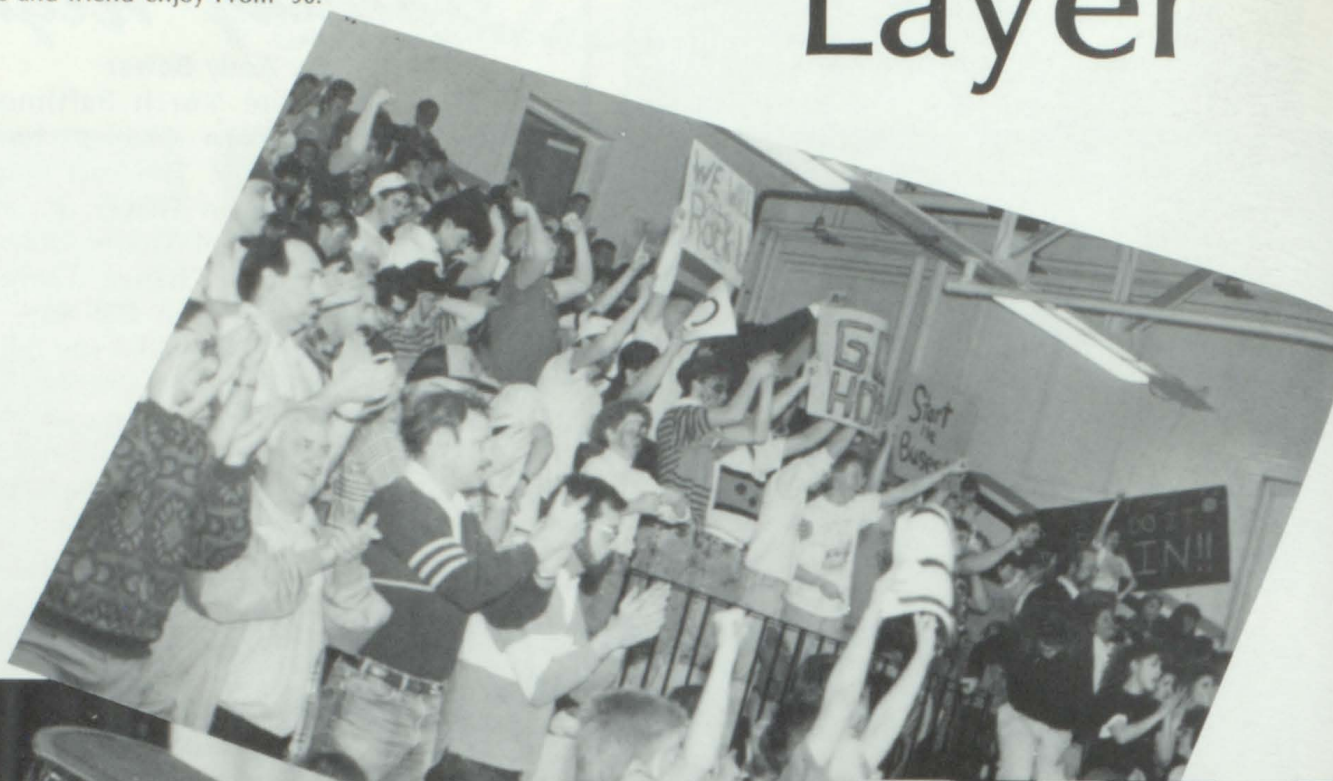
