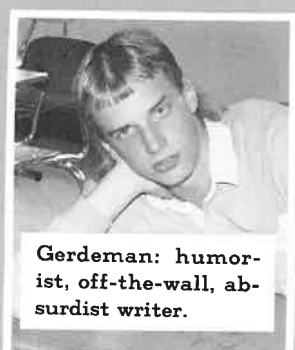

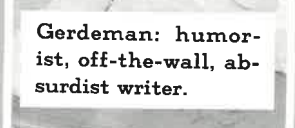

We liked the idea that each year is a new beginning, even though many things are standard from year to year—the daily schedule, football in the fall, prom in the spring.

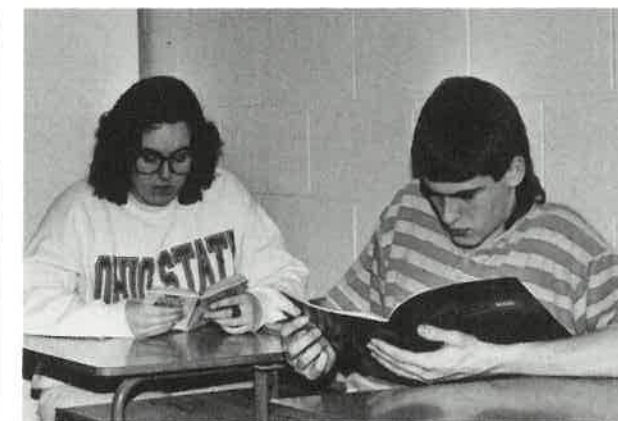
This staff truly felt that it is the regular, traditional, everyday "ingredients," coupled with the unique happenings of this year that made attending NBHS in 1992 memorable.

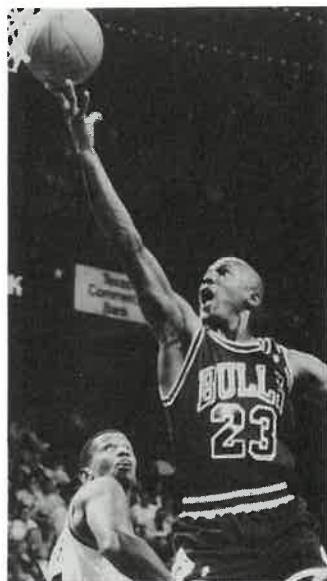

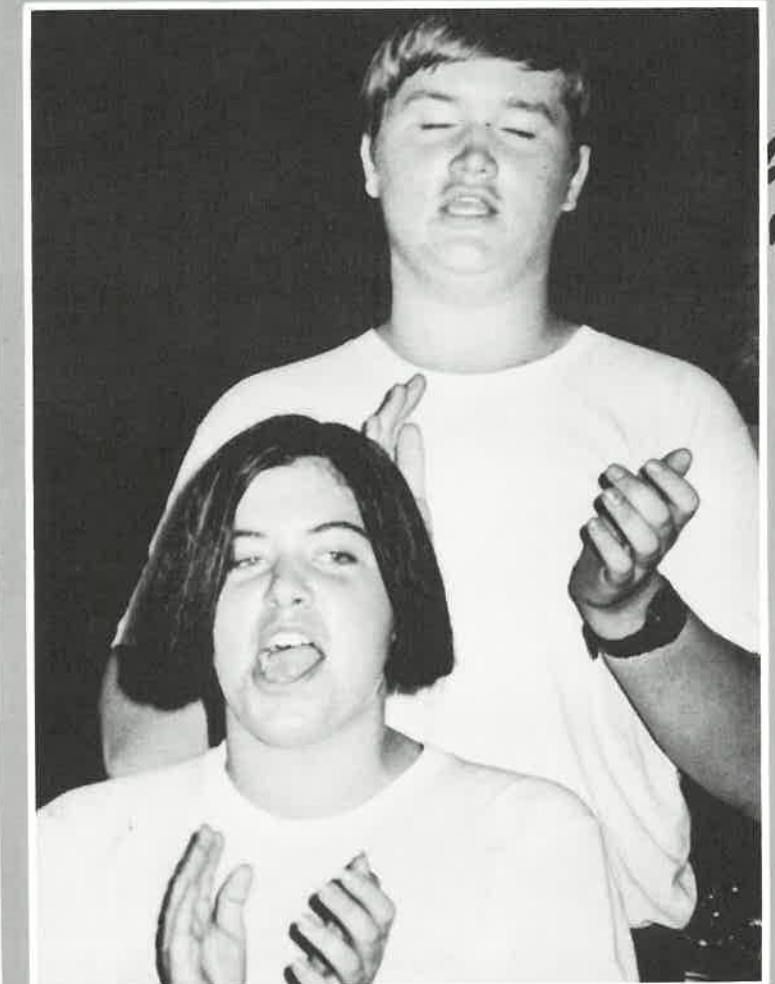

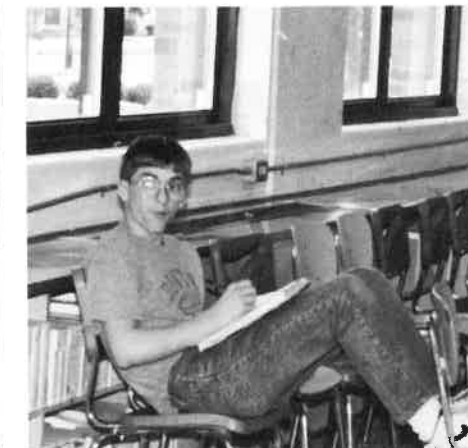
