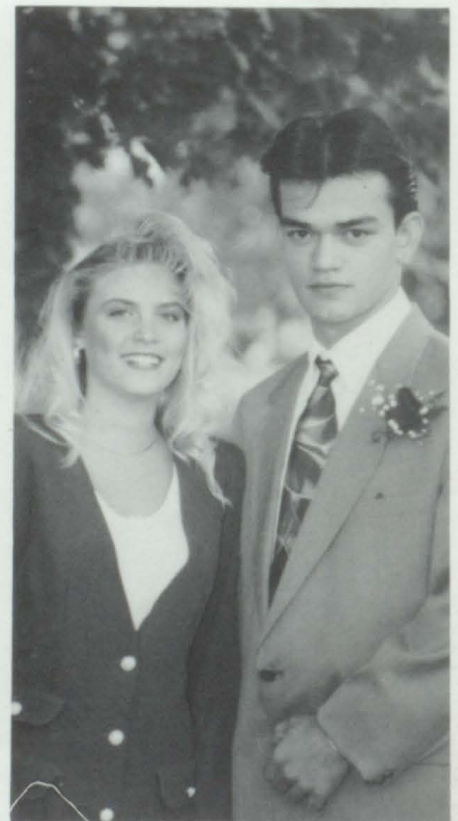
Finally, on October 15, 1993 the Tigers came face to face with their opponent, the Chieftains (Hopewell Loudon.) The skies

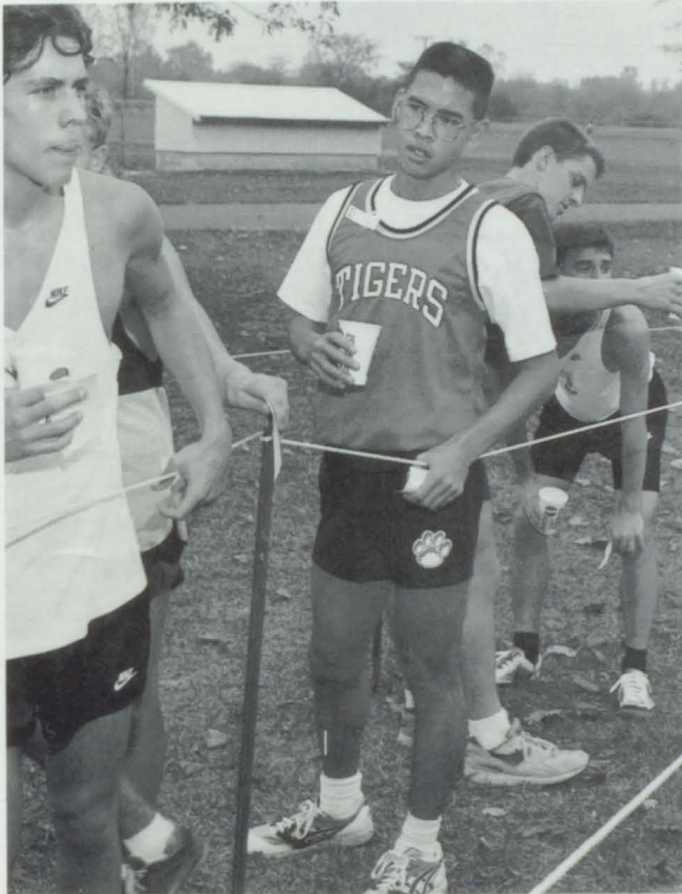

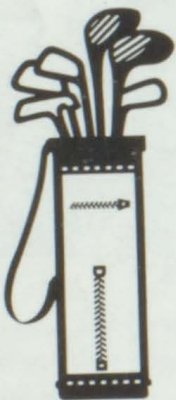
