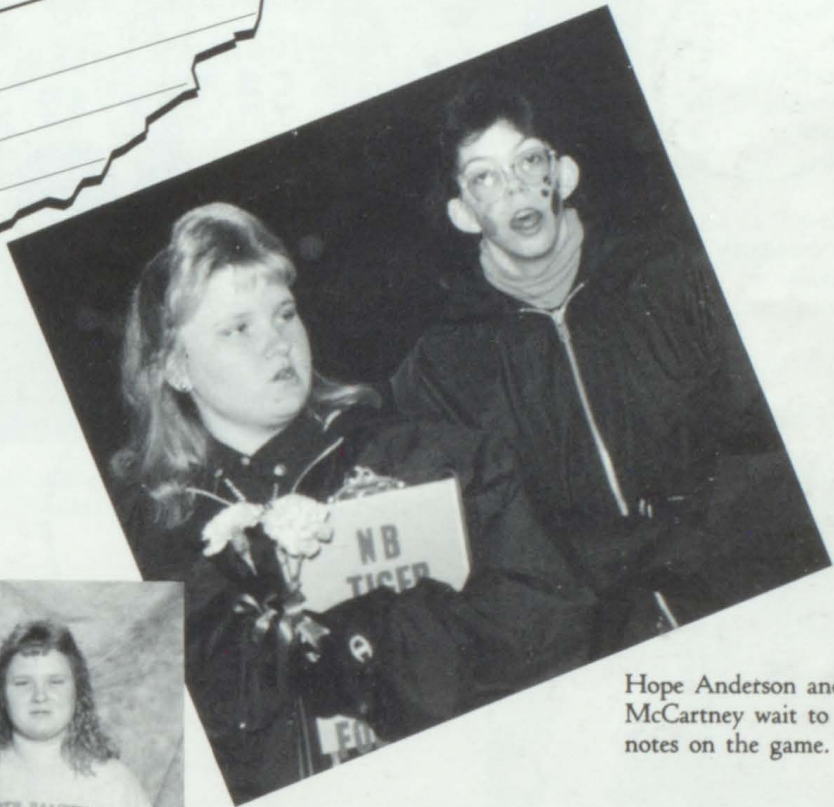

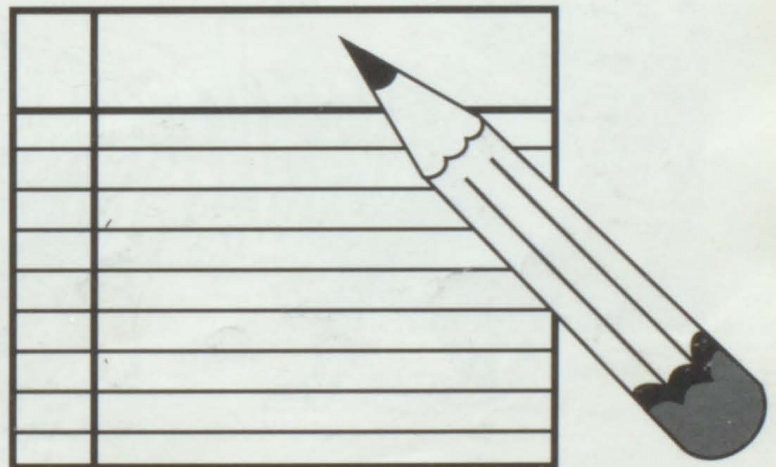

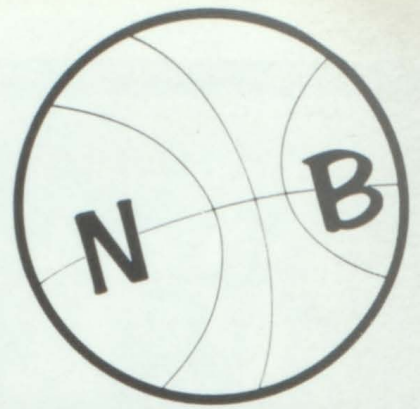


Saundra and Shelly attempt to stop the opponent from going to the basket.

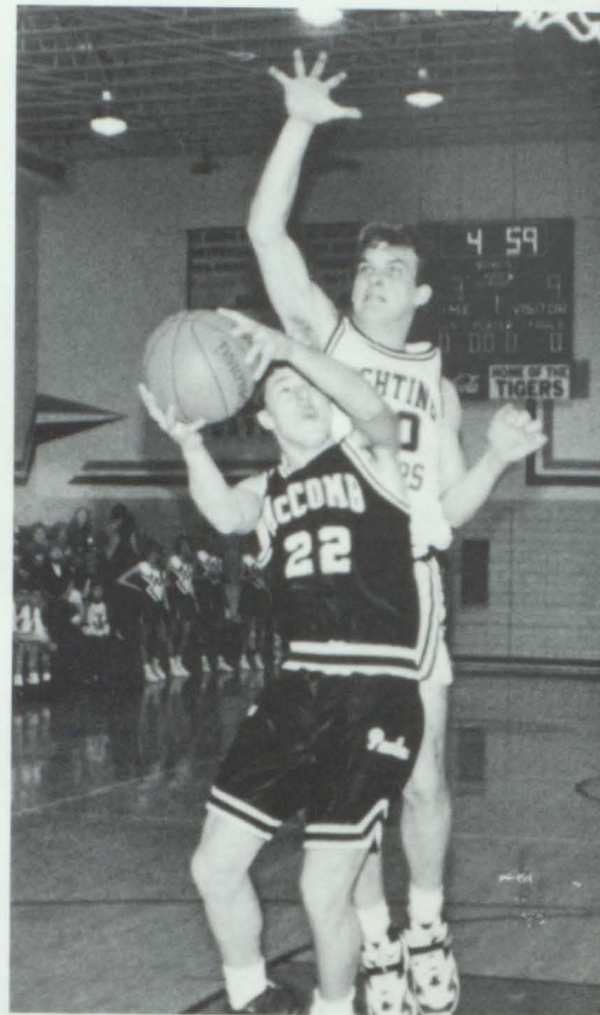
The fighting Tigers are looking forward to a promising season next year because of the loss of no seniors.

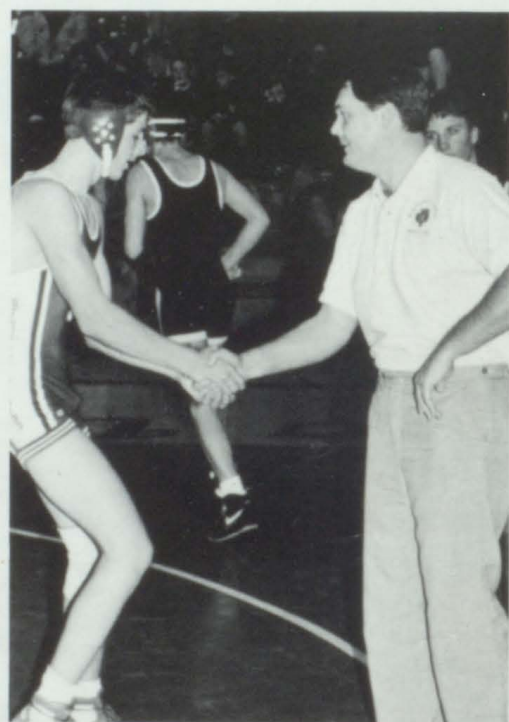

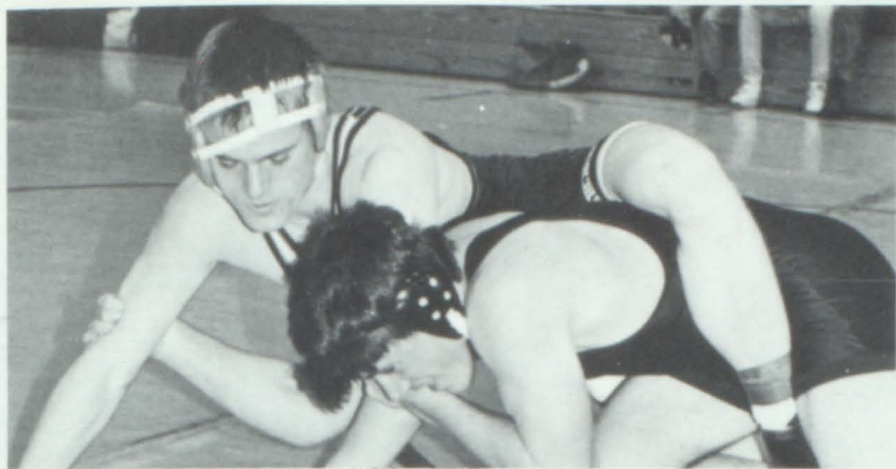

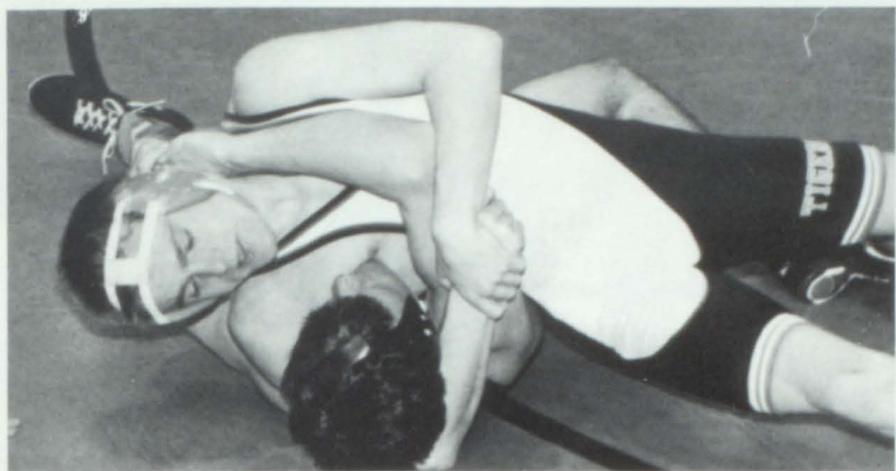

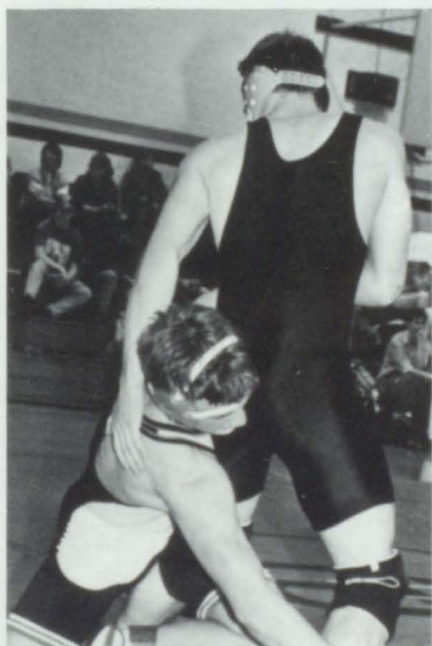
