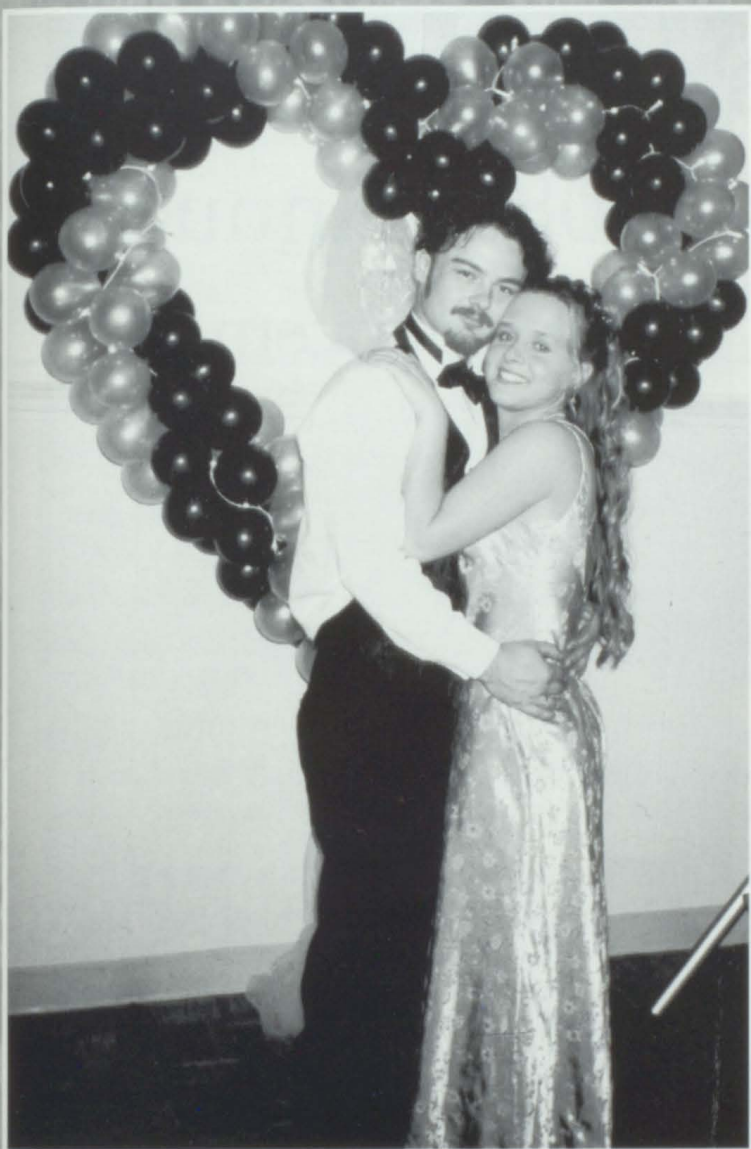

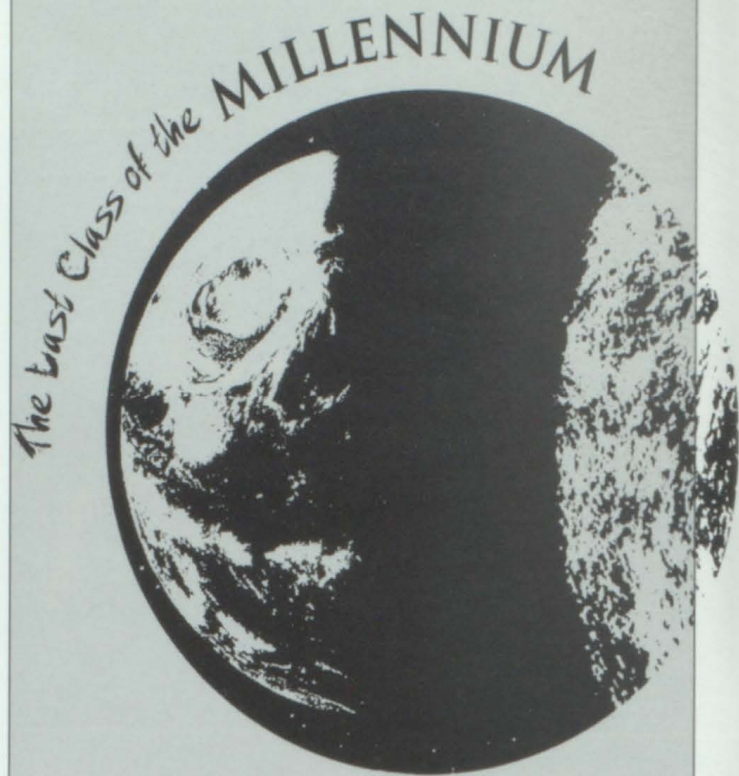

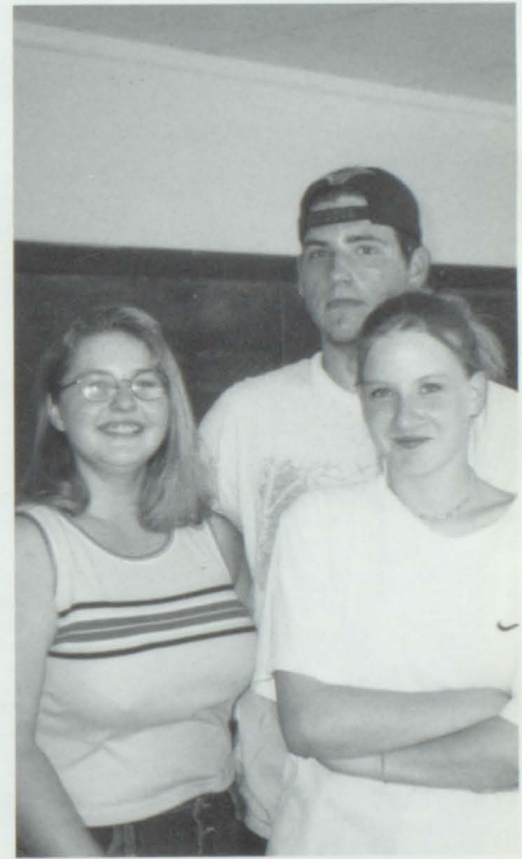

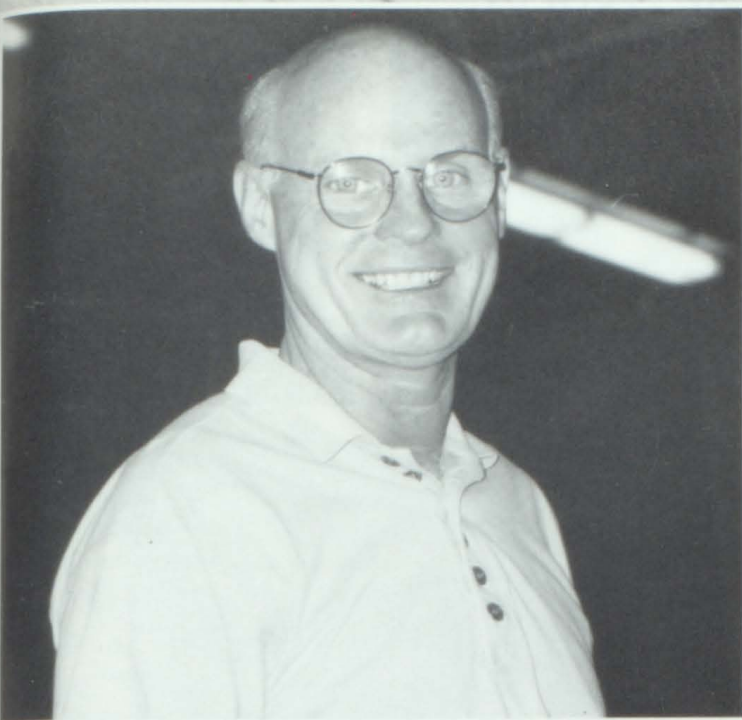

Mr. Thompson:

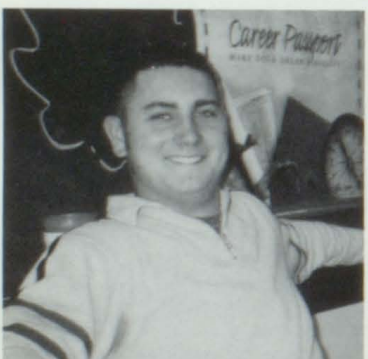
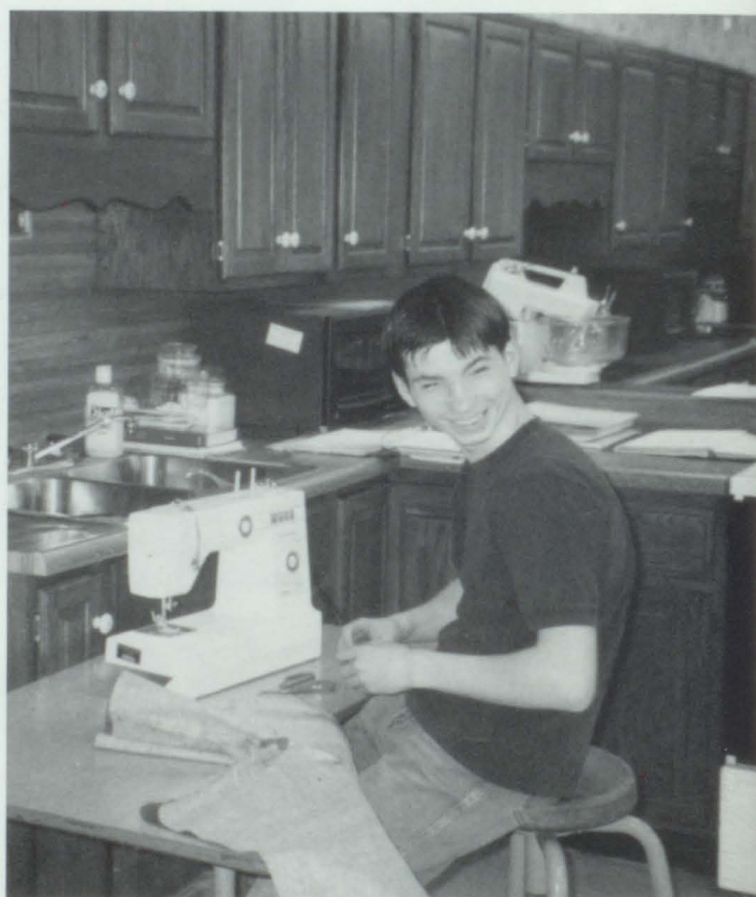
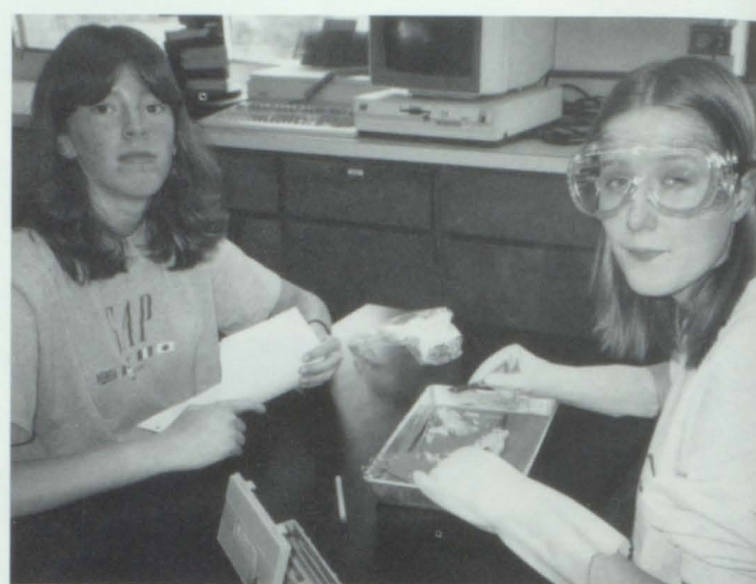
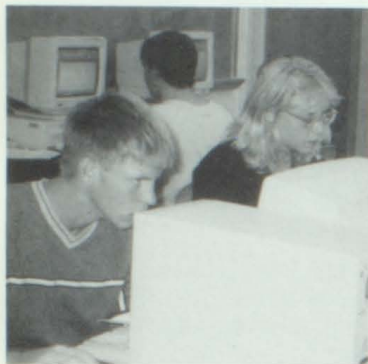
Q: What was your most memorable moment?
