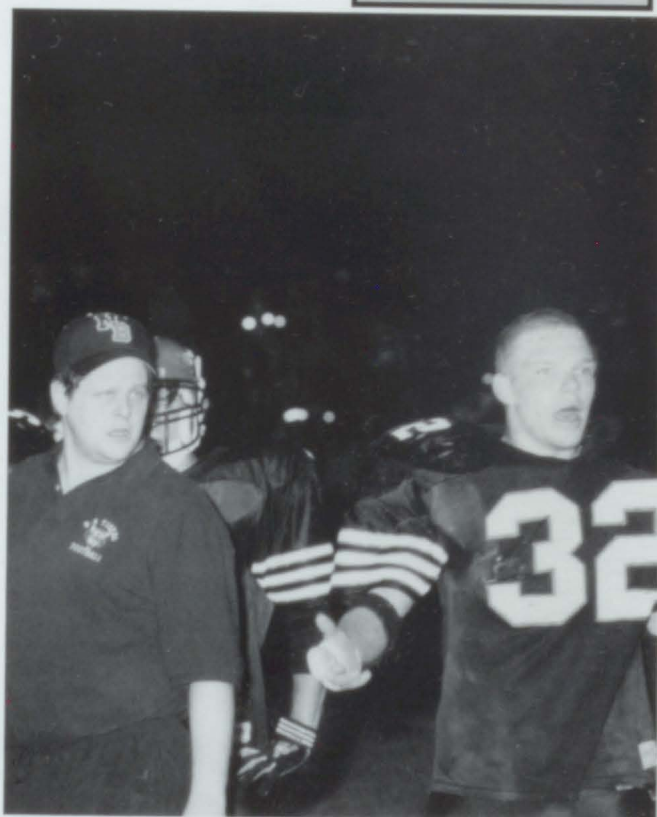

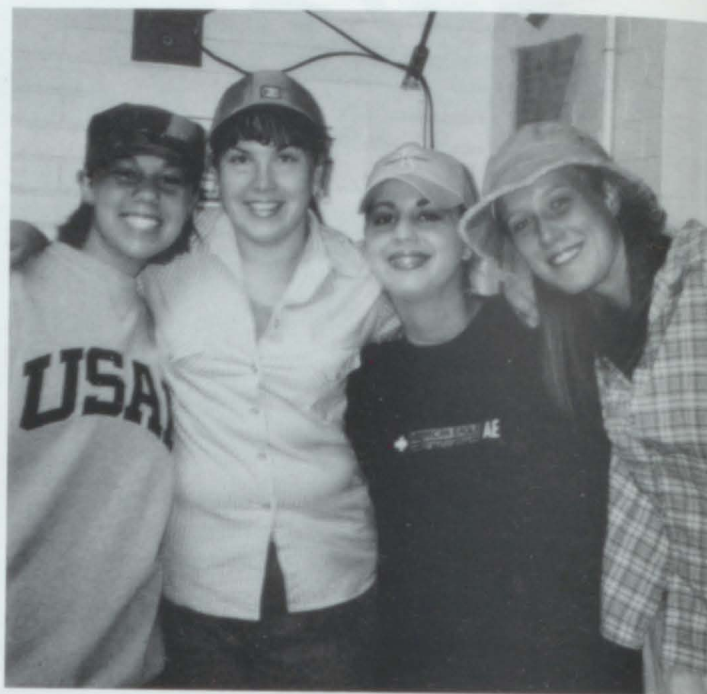

Thursday night we had a bonfire at the football field where loyal Tiger fans of all ages gathered to cheer for a victory.

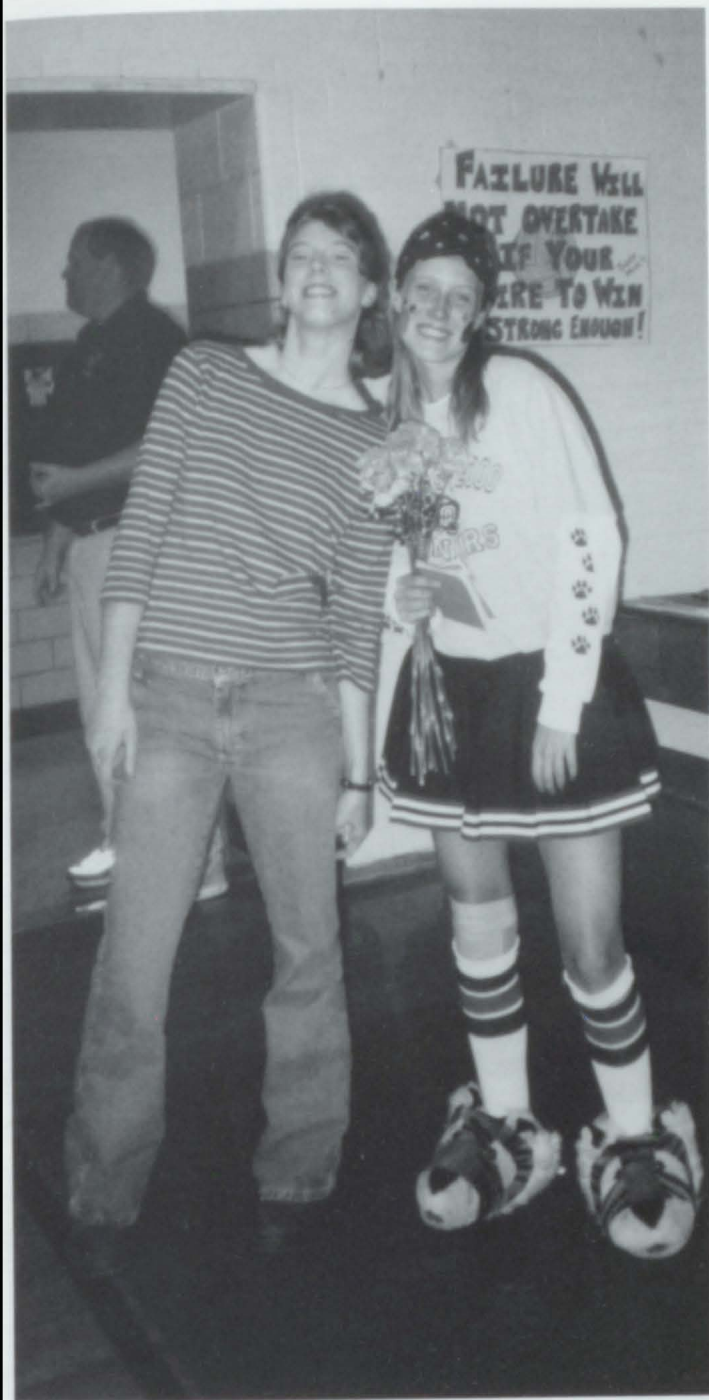
Friday was our pep rally where the Homecoming court and football team were introduced.

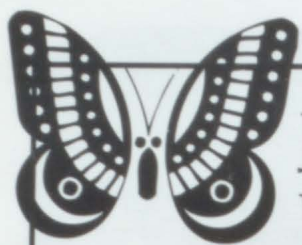

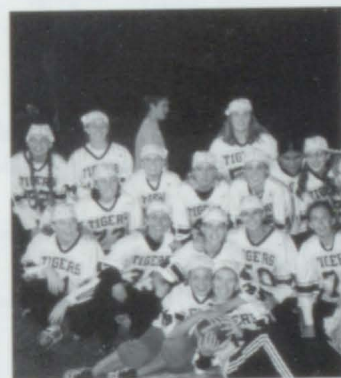

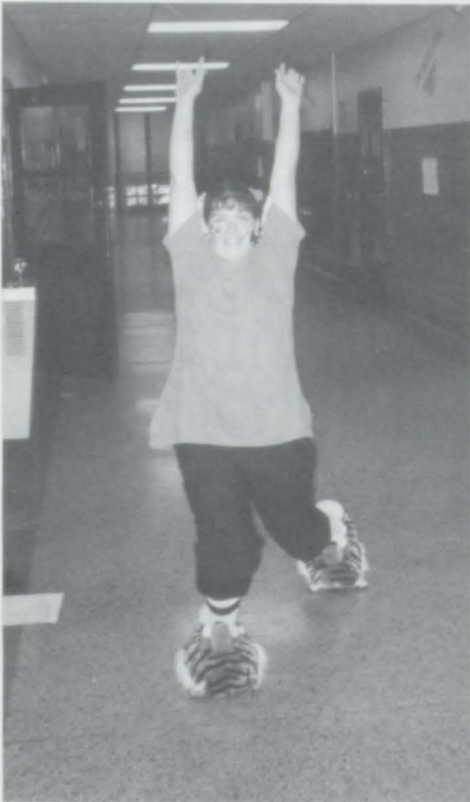

1999 NBHS Tiger Golf Team

A total of 13 young men competed on The Tiger Golf Team in 1999. We finished the year with a 14-6 dual match record. The Tigers finished 4th out of 13 in the Tiger Invitational, 4th out of 11 in the MAL Tournament, 3rd out of 17 in the Sectional Tournament and 6th out of 15 in the first District Tournament for the Tigers in 19 years. With tournaments included our record was 53 wins and 19 losses.

Our 9-hole average for the year was 171.7, this is an improvement of 7.4 strokes over 1998. These improvements were due to improving our course management skills...which is eliminating double bogies and 3 putts, and improving short games.

The Junior Varsity finished the season with a 13-6 record. This is also the first time in years that we had a full JV squad and the first winning record for the JV in a long time, if not the first ever!
