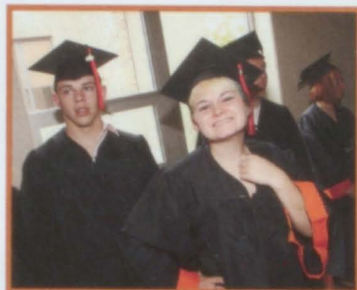
SENIOR PICNIC

One Last Fun Day Before the Finish

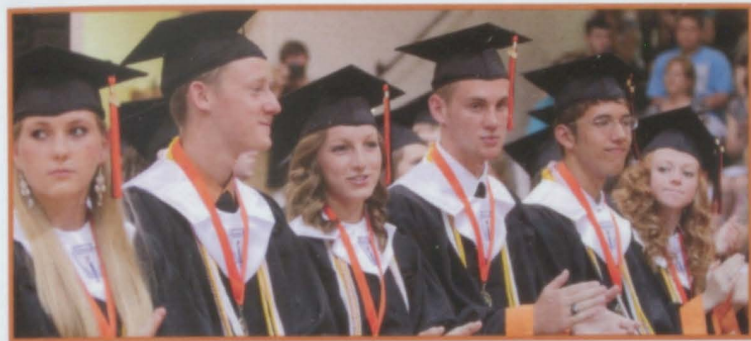
