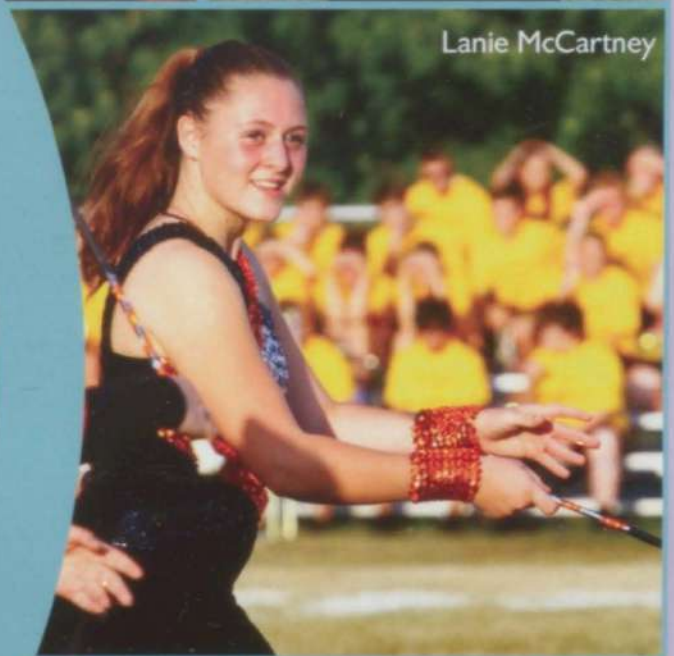

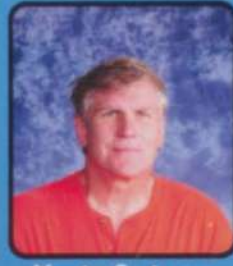

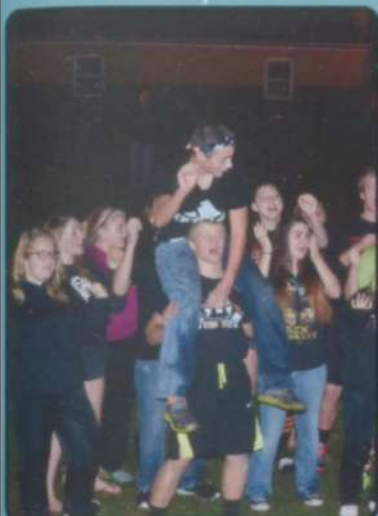


"I think the junior class did very well during the cheer competition. I felt like we were all excited and pumped. We all, definitely, tried our best," said Alyssah Leary.

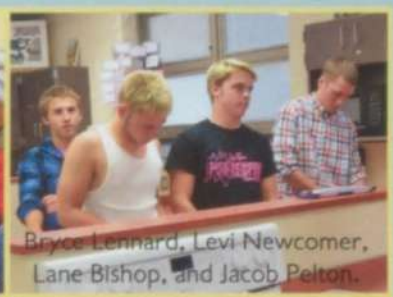

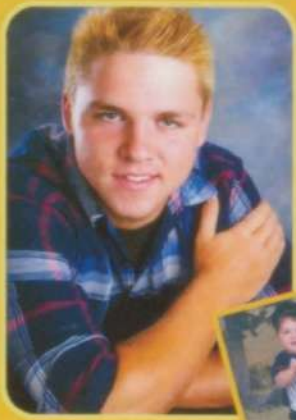
