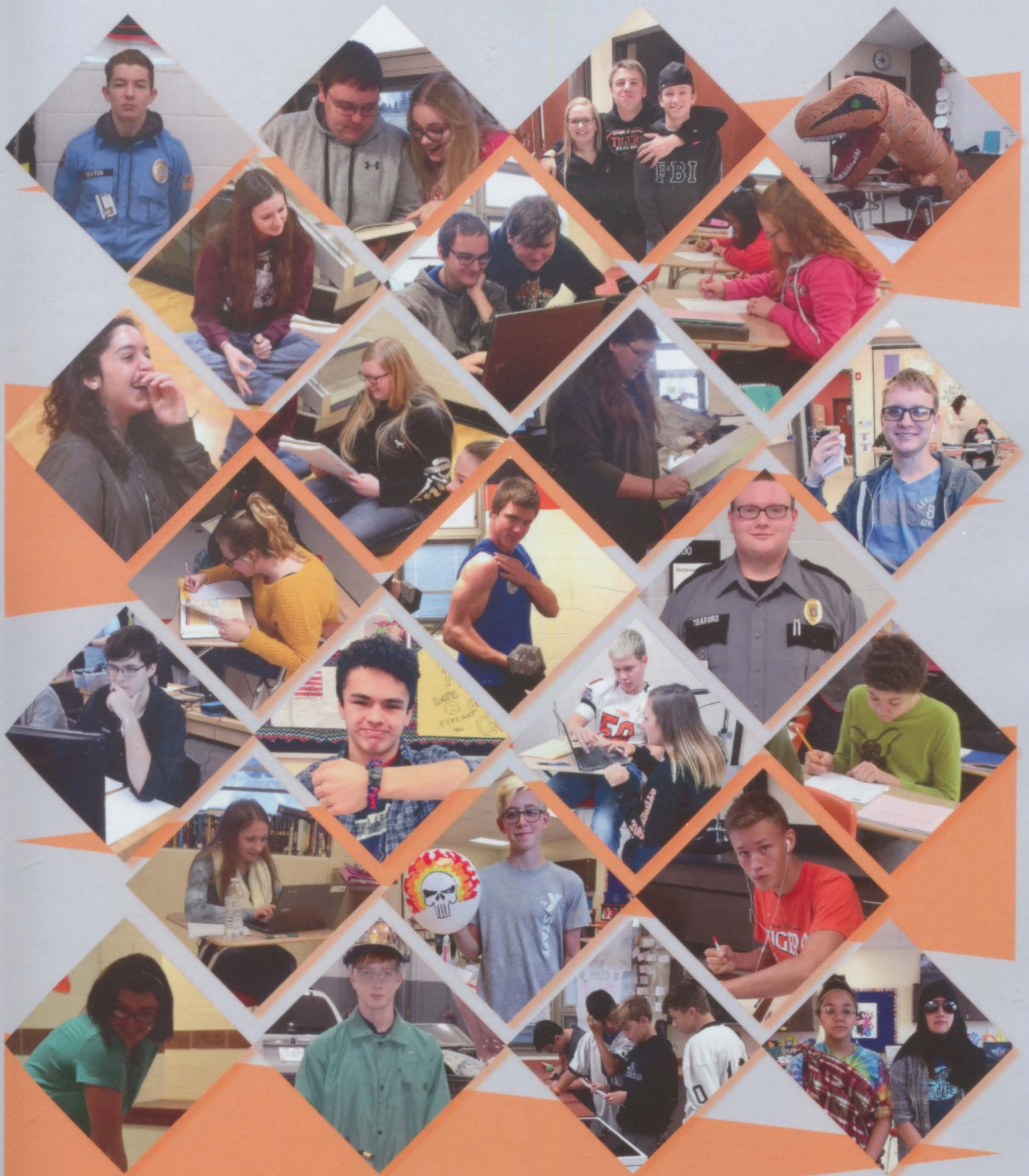
The Foreign Exchange Students

"I like that I can express my creativity," said Grace Hagemyer.

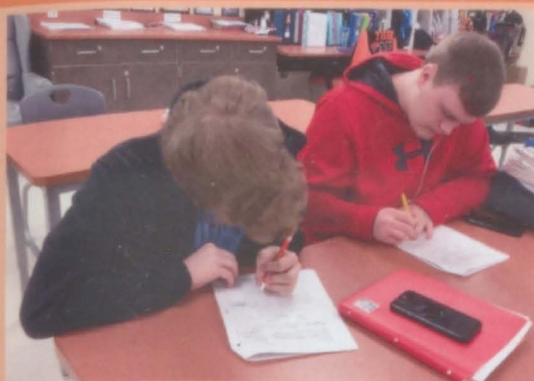
"I think my favorite project this year was the paper mache because it allowed it to be 3D," said Lucy Trout.

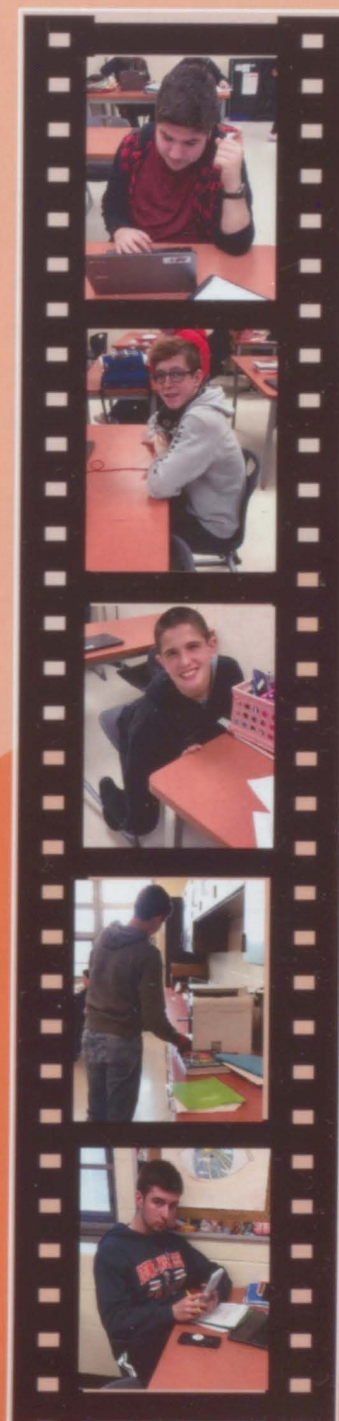
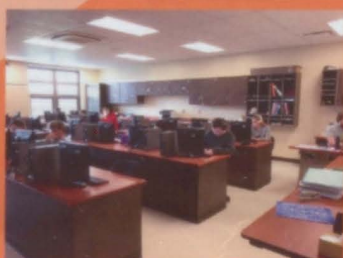


"My favorite thing about Business was when Paige scared Mr. Daniels periodically throughout the semester," said Jonathan Patterson.

"I like Choir because you can be yourself without getting judged, and I like how social we can be," said Austin Gibson.

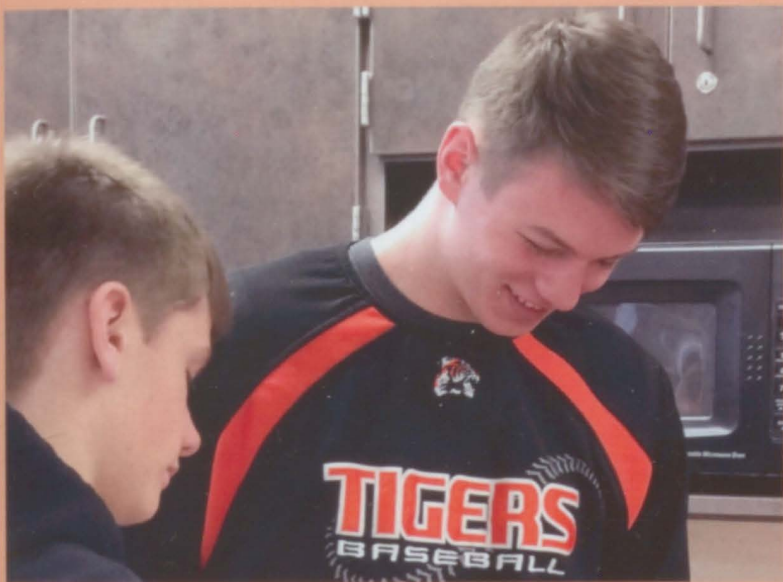
"Choir is a great way for us to get closer, not only in pitch, but as a family," said Malachi Combs.

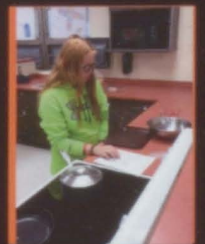
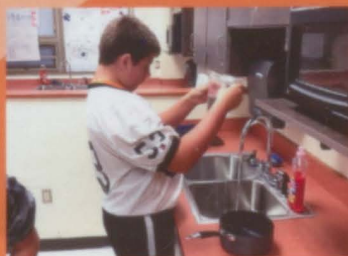
"I like Child Development because it gives you a hands on learning experience with children," said Makenna Ray.

"I enjoy teaching so the students can see the connections between history and thier lives," said Mrs. Traver.

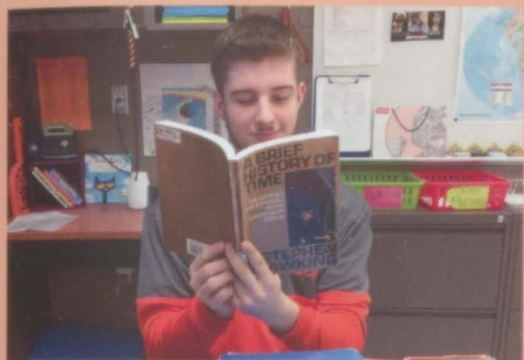
"This class has helped me realize how history tends to repeat over time, just not in the same ways," said Richard Kreisher.

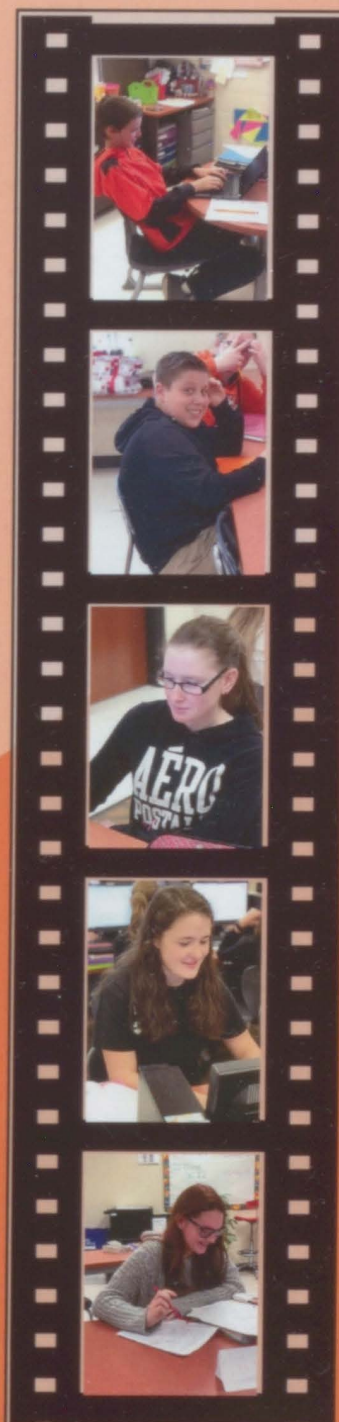
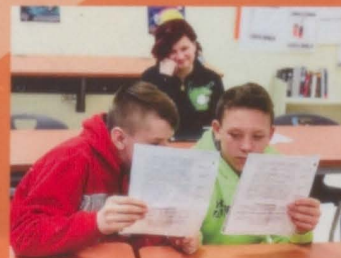


"Going to the University of Findlay with the College Readiness classes was a great opportunity because it allowed us to get a sense of what college life will be like," said Jordan Bucher.

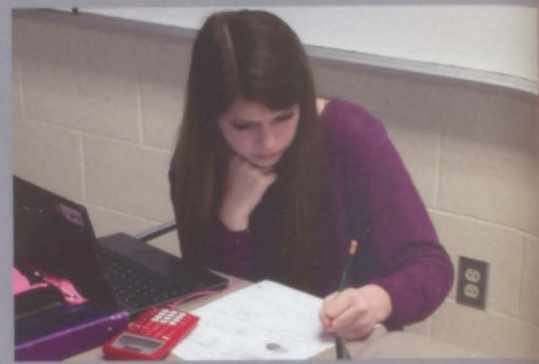
"I really enjoyed this class because it taught me more about writing and my skills have improved greatly throughout as well," said Hanna Rose.

Mathematics



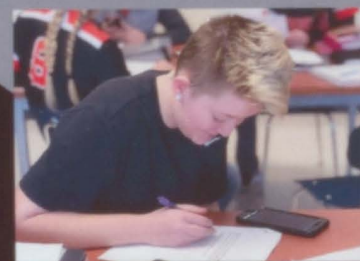
"I like math because it shows me that I can get the same answer in many different ways," said Mercedes Ankney.

Physical Education

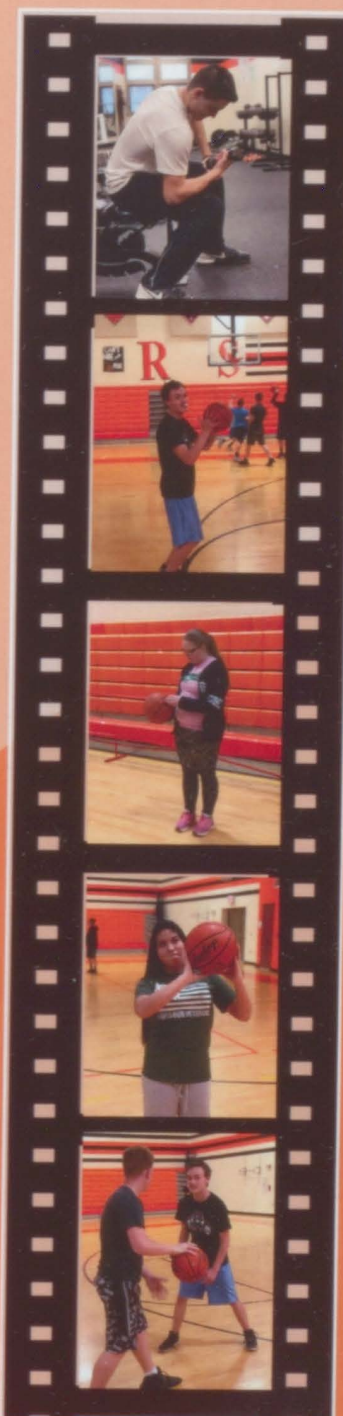

"Dissecting the cats was by far the best part of the class. They may have smelled terrible, but it was very interesting to dissect them," said Grace Rein.

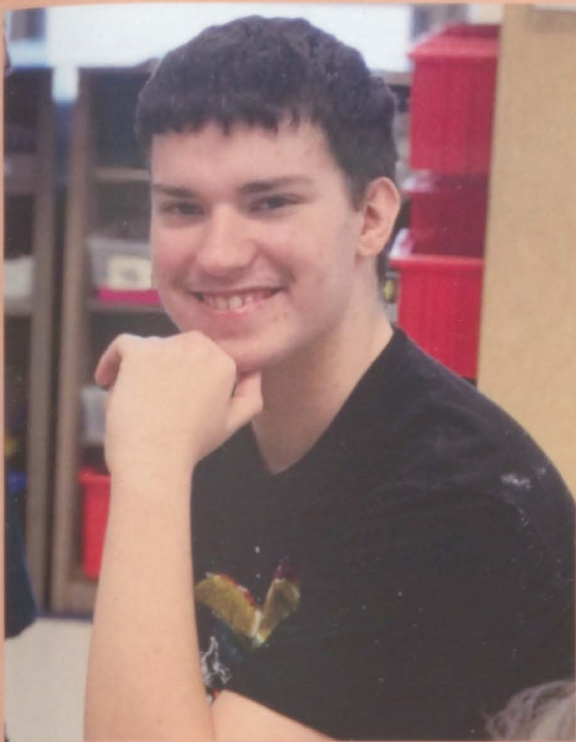
"My favorite part of physics was the Random Toast Tuesday's and listening to 'Hot Hot Hot'," said Hunter Wymer.
