

North Baltimore Public Libby and E-cards

 - Anyone with a Library Card


- How do you use these systems

- We will start with answering yes we have a library card.




- Now we need to choose are library by searching for it.
- We will use our zip code 45872 to find our library.




• Next we will choose the North Baltimore Public Library as


our home library.




- We will now be on the home page of Libby, but before we start looking for books we need to put your e-card numbers in Libby.
- Click on sign in with my card.




• Choose the North Baltimore Public Library.



• Now you will put in your e-card number that was given to you.




• And then your pin number which also is on your card.




• Then click Sign In


You should get this message.

• Apply filters







Now you can start looking for a book.

• Click on the magnifying glass at the bottom of the screen.


• The type in the book, author or subject that you would like


to look up.
