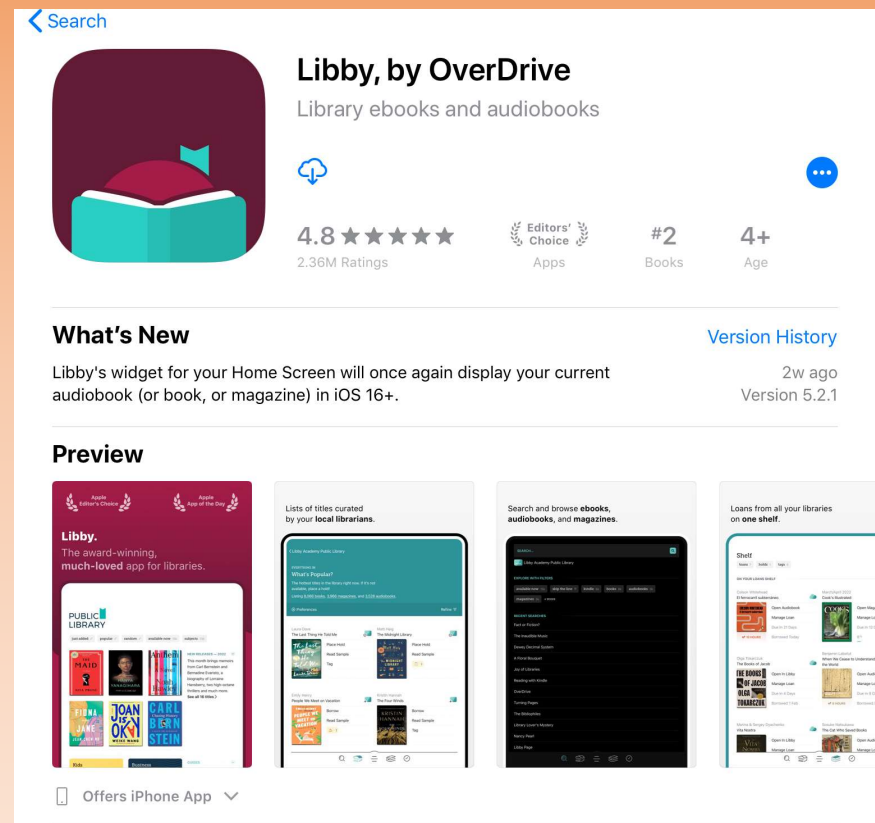


# North Baltimore Public Libby and E-cards

- We will start with answering yes we have a library card.



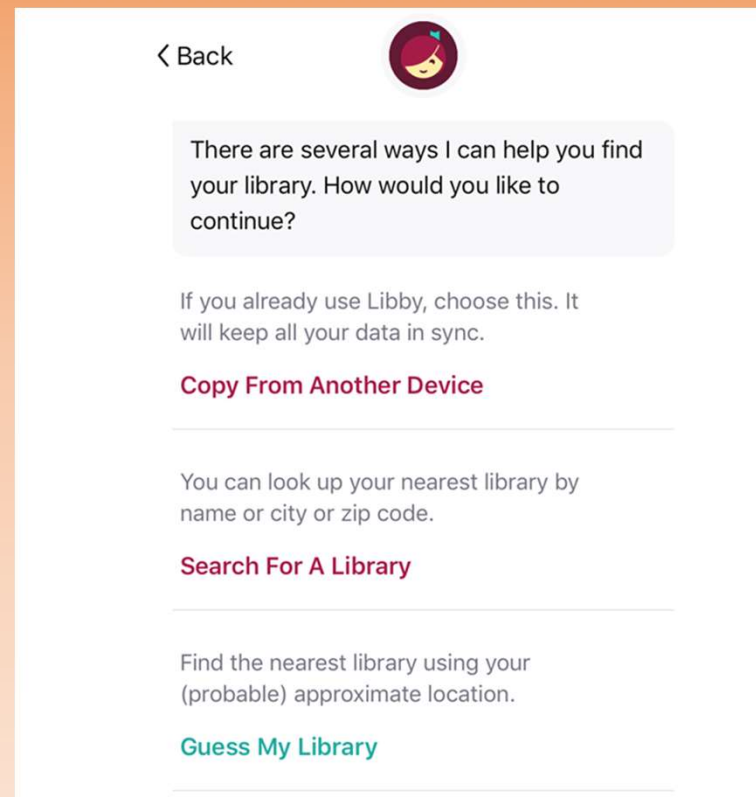
Welcome! Thousands of public libraries offer ebooks and audiobooks (for free!) in Libby. Let me ask you a few questions, to guide you to your library.

First question: do you have **a library card**?

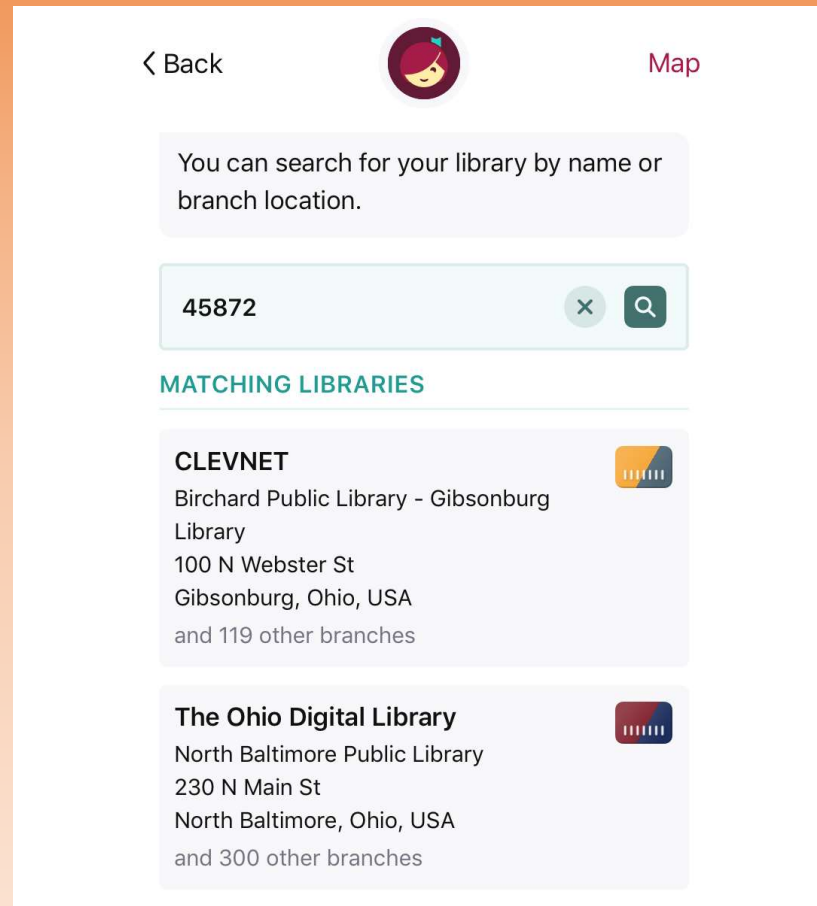

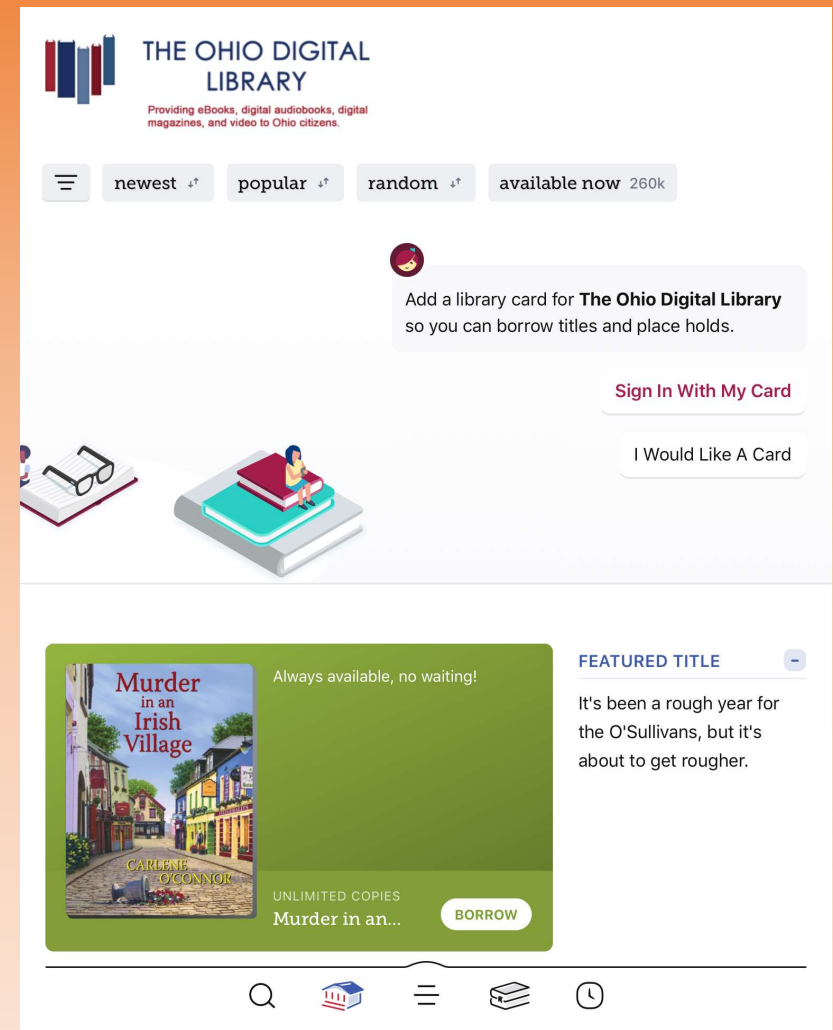
- Now we need to choose a library by searching for it.



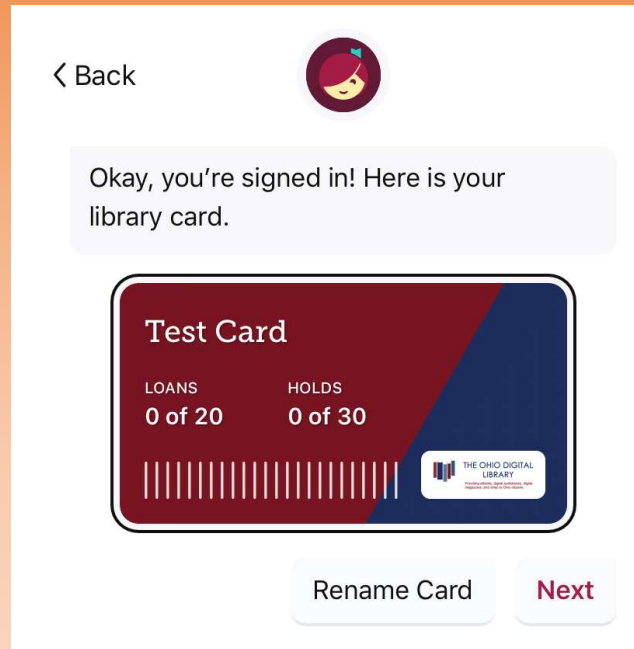
- And then your pin number which also is on your card.

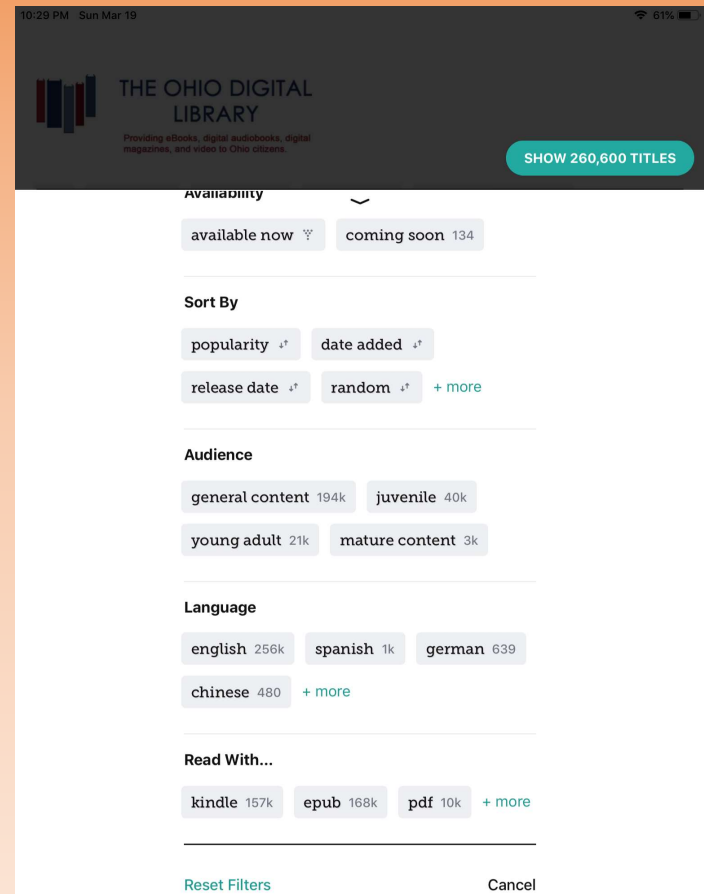
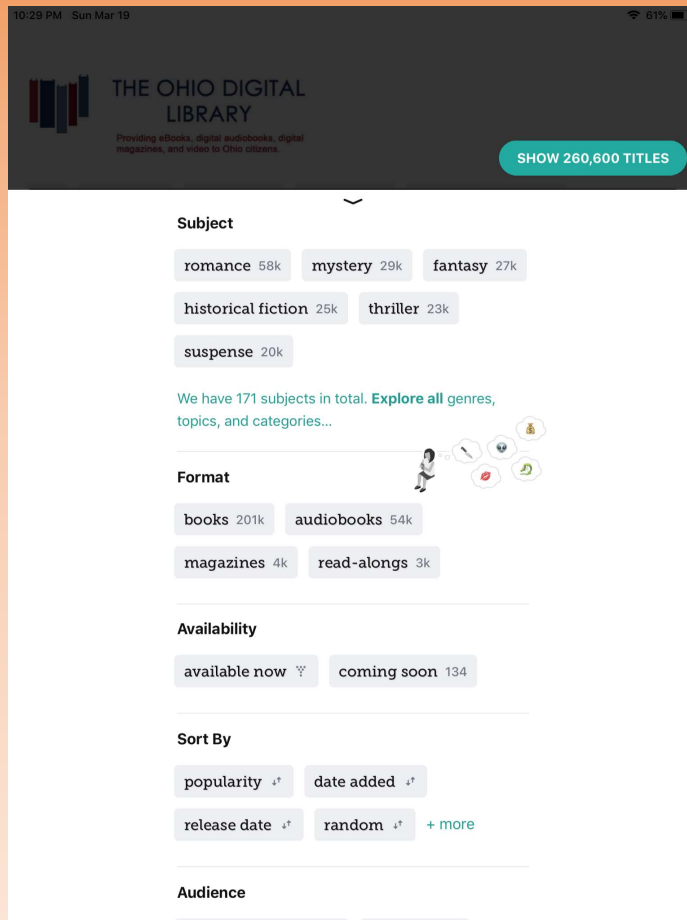
- Then click Sign In

- When you are asked about reading on a Kindle you can click skip


- Apply filters

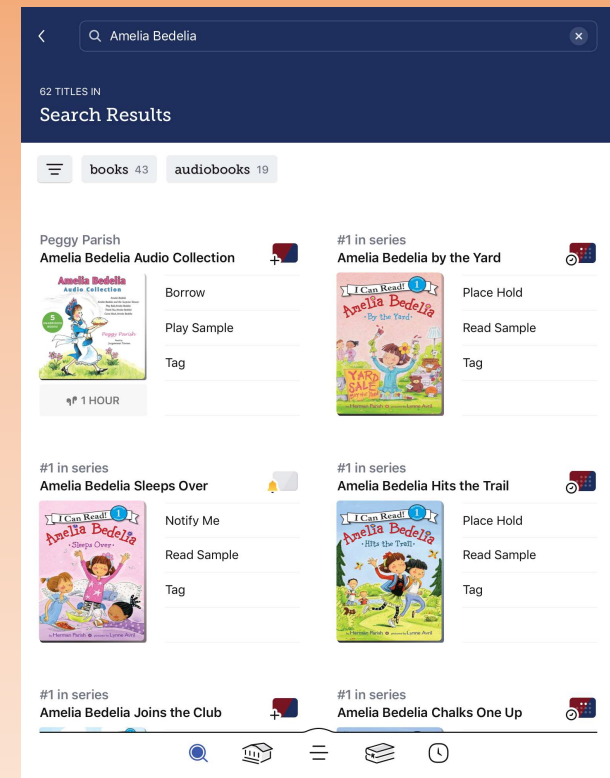

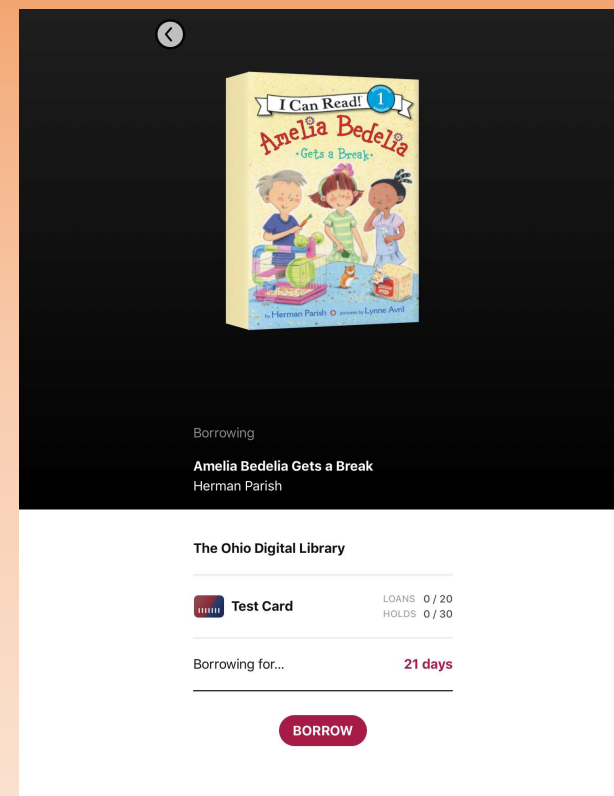
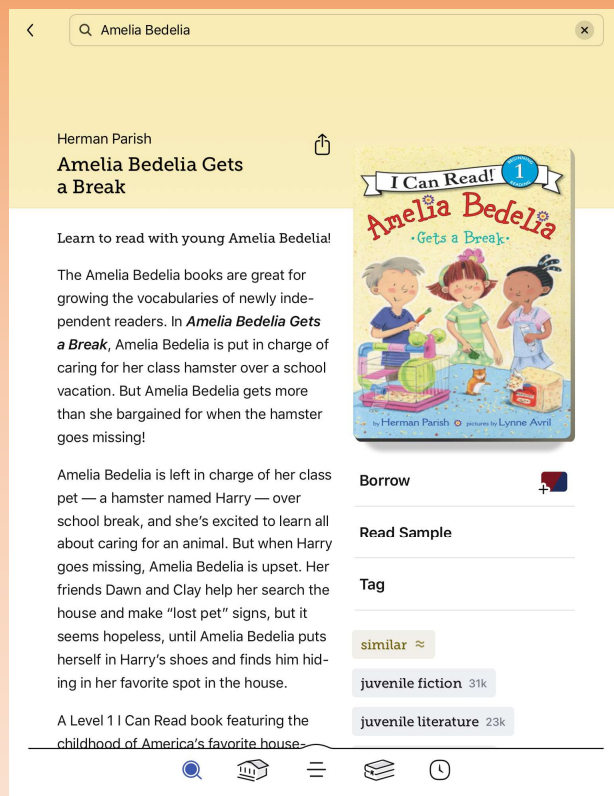
